SAN GABRIEL. June 24 .- Circumstances of a trainc accident which shortly before midnight last Friday resulted in fatal injuries to a woman tentatively identified by deputy sheriffs as Lillian B. Houghton, 45, whose last known address was 6521 Homewood avenue, Los Angeles, will be reviewed by a Coroner's jury at 2 p.m. tomorrow at the Du Bois Funeral Home here. Officers reported the young woman was killed when an automobile i

driven by Houghton overturned follewing a collision with another car at Valley Boulevard and New avenue. Officer: stated they found a broken five-gallon can which contained alcohol under the car driven by Houghton, who was taken to the prison ward of the General Hospital suffering from head and other injuries.

Mrs. Gus Carlson, 1233 Muscate street, Rosemend, driver of the other car, and three passengers, including two girls and a woman, were given emergency treatment for injuries in Alnambra, necording to a Sheriff's report.
