REV. CHARLES A. STROMBOM

Former Curate of Trinity Church Dies in Johnstown, Pa.

Word was received here last night of the death Saturday in the Johnstown (Pa.) Hospital of the Rev. Charles Alexander Strombom, Episcopal clergyman, who had been rector of St. Mark's Church in Johnstown since 1923. Funeral services will be held at his church on Wednesday. Mr. Strombom was born April 20, 1874, in the Bahamas, a son of the Rev. William Henry Strombom. He attended the College of St. Peter and St. Paul in England, was ordained a deacon in 1898 and advanced to the priesthood the following year by the Bishop of Nassau.
