

Dr. Dorothy Houghton Dies, Food-Chemistry Specialist

Dr. Dorothy Houghton, a specialist in food chemistry and nutrition, died Monday at Phelps Memorial Hospital, North Tarrytown, N. Y. She was 74 years old and lived at Tarrytown.

Dr. Houghton, a graduate of Barnard College and Columbia University, joined the faculty of Pennsylvania State University in 1952 as assistant dean for resident instruction. At her retirement in 1966 she was dean of the College of Human Development.

Before going to Penn State she was an instructor in chemistry at Packer Collegiate Institute, Brooklyn, and an associate professor in the home economics department of Teachers College, Columbia University.

At her death she was an administrative officer of E. W. Axe and Company, investment counselors.

There are no immediate survivors.

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
