

GIVES \$10,000 TO VASSAR.

Miss E. G. Houghton Establishes
Florence M. Cushing Memorial Fund.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., Nov. 26.
—Vassar College has announced a memorial gift of \$10,000 to establish the Florence M. Cushing fund for cultural reading, by Miss Elizabeth G. Houghton of Boston, a graduate of the class of 1873.

Florence M. Cushing served as librarian of the college from 1874 to 1876. She was instrumental in founding the Raymond Reading Room in the main building, in memory of the first President, John H. Raymond, whose public readings of English literature were among the features of the early days at Vassar.

The income from the fund will be employed to sustain the Raymond Reading Room and, in part at least, a library in the new Hall of Residence, opened this Autumn and named in honor of Miss Cushing.
