
ENGAGED AS PAGEANT ENDS.

Miss Houghton Represented Marie Antoinette and Mr. Don Louis XIV.

SARATOGA, N. Y., Aug. 25.—An illuminated parade and carnival in which the participants in the Saratoga pageant were reviewed by the Second Company of the Governor's Footguard of New Haven, Conn., brought the pageant to a close early this morning after the last performance in Congress Spring Park. The guard was in town on its way from Canada, where the members have been visiting.

More than 30,000 spectators witnessed the pageant during the week, and it probably will be repeated next year.

The engagement was announced to-day of Miss Elizabeth Houghton, daughter of Justice and Mrs. James W. Houghton of New York City, to Stuart Morrison Don of Troy, a graduate of Princeton University. Miss Houghton represented Marie Antoinette and Mr. Don was Louis XIV. in the pageant.
