PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 16—The Rev. Dr. Frederick P. Houghton, executive secretary of the Protestant Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania since 1937, died here yesterday in the Naval Hospital at the age of 67.

Dr. Houghton, who resided in Doylestown, served as an Army chaplain in both world wars. A graduate of the General Theological Seminary in 1916, he began his active ministry in Scranton.

He leaves his wife, the former Catherine Edwards; two sons, Robert, of Doylestown, and Frederick, Jr., of Beaumont, Tex., and a brother.
