An addendum to yesterday's info:

Evelyne Keith called me last night with the results of her search of the Pre-1907 Vital Records fiche. Said she found a death for Johannah GASNER who died in Tn. Franklin, Kewaunee Co., 1 Dec 1888. She is buried in Catholic Cem., Cooperstown, Mtwc. Co. She was married to Anton GASNER, born U.S., and age 50 yrs. (She also checked death records at Court House.)

Tombstone inscriptions from St. James' Coop., give Anton GASSNER 24 Dec. 1824 - 8 Oct 1906 and Hannah 12 Aug 1839 - 1 Dec 1888.

There was no obit in "Lake Shore Times" or "Pilot", but she checked the 1880 census for Tn. Franklin, Kewaunee Co., and found:

Hannah 41 b. Pa.

Joseph son 16 b. Wis.

Mary dau 11 "

Catherine" 3 "

Also from the fiche index: Marriage Johanna GASSNER
21 May 1895, Kewaunee Co.

17 Feb 1858, Kewaunee Co.

(Elijah's marriage record at Reg. of Deeds is spelled HOLTON also.)

(I also noticed HOLTON entries in Grantor-Grantee books, but not Elijah or Hannah.)

Birth Catherine GASNER 21 Sep 1876, Kewaunee Co.

Evelyne did not find any GASNERs in Tn. Franklin, Kew. Co., in 1870 census.

In unindexed marriages I found a Martha HOUGHTON, Tn. T.R.

married to Johann BAUER, Tn. T.R., 31 Dec 1851.
Witnesses were Francis HEYNE and Henry BEITZOLD. The
marriage was by a Justice of the Peace.

Some of this may be extraneous to your search, but the GASNER name added another avenue to check.
