

AUTO UPSET KILLS TWO.

Mrs. Hutton Is Killed Outright,
Companion Dies Later.

NORTH ADAMS, Mass., Aug. 1.—Mrs. Robert Hutton of New York, wife of a physician, was killed outright and Miss Mary Houghton of this city was mortally hurt when their automobile overturned today. Miss Houghton died in a hospital late this afternoon.

John Withers, the chauffeur, said that in trying to avoid the dust from a fresh coating of gravel, he drove too near the edge of the road.

Mrs. Hutton was the wife of Dr. Robert L. Hutton of 18 East Fiftieth Street, whose residence is at 114 East Seventy-first Street. She was born and brought up in North Adams, and went there some weeks ago on a visit to her parents. Dr. Hutton joined her day before yesterday for a short vacation. She leaves a 3-year-old son.
