

MRS. G. W. HOWELL WEDS.

**Widow of Rev. Dr. Howell Married to
Percy D. Houghton, Harvard Coach.**

LENOX, Mass., May 15.—In Plumbsted, the country residence of Mrs. Joseph S. Whistler, her niece, Mrs. Gwendolyn Whistler Howell, was married at 4 o'clock this afternoon to Percy D. Haughton of Boston. Only the immediate families witnessed the ceremony, which was read by the Rev. Sherrard Billings of Groton, Mass. The house decorations were pink and white apple blossoms and other flowers of the season.

The bride's cousin, Miss Nina Gaither of Baltimore, was her only attendant. The bride wore a close-fitting gown of gray broadcloth and a hat to correspond. Mr. Haughton was attended by J. Wells Farley of Boston.

The bride was the widow of the Rev. Dr. Richard Lewis Howell, the millionaire clergyman of Baltimore. He married her before she had been introduced in society at Palm Beach in 1905. She inherited a large fortune on his death a year ago. Mr. Haughton is head coach of the Harvard football teams.
