4. James Marshall Thomas³ Elliott was born February 15, 1839 in Anson Co. North Carolina. He married Martha Collins. She was born January 08, 1838 in Alabama.

According to Biographical and Historical Memoirs of Northwest Louisiana, Southern Publishing Company, Chicago & Nashville, 1890, "He obtained a common-school education and learned the details of agriculture on his father's plantation. After devoting his time to tilling

the soil until June 13, 1862, he joined Company B, Eleventh Louisiana Battalion, and served until May, 1865, but during this time was taken prisoner April 14, 1863, on the gunboat "Queen of The West." which was then on Grand Lake, in Louisiana. After his return home at the close of the war, he resumed farming, continuing until he was appointed parish assessor by Gov. P. A. Wiltz. April 16, 1884, he was elected to the responsible position of sheriff of Red River Parish, was re-elected in 1888, and his present term will expire in 1892. No more capable man for the position could be found than Mr. Elliott, and owing to his geniality and desire to oblige, he is very popular with all.

"Mr. Elliott has always been a Democrat, and socially is a member of the Silent Brotherhood Lodge No. 146 of the A. F. & A. M. He and his wife are prominent members of the Missionary Baptist Church of Coushatta"
