

Mayor & City Council of Anceston } in the City
v.s. } Court of Anceston
Mrs. Ashley & A.R. Ross }

In this case it is admitted by the parties
hereto that on the 20th day of August 1889
the Defendant Mrs. Ashley was fined by the
Recorder of the City of Anceston, in a case
which was regularly tried before him, the
sum of One Hundred (\$100⁰⁰) Dollars
for the violation of an ordinance of said City
of Anceston forbidding the sale of spirituous
wines or malt liquors without a license.
That on said day an appeal was taken by said Ashley
from the fine imposed on him by the Recorder of said
City to the City Court of Anceston and about
the month A.R. Ross was his security on
said bond. That the Defendant Mrs. Ashley failed
to appear in the said City Court and judgment
was rendered by the City Court of Anceston
on Jan - 20/890 affirming the (for the sum
One Hundred (\$100⁰⁰) Dollars affirming the fine
judgment of the Recorder Court imposing a
fine of one Hundred Dollars against said
Mrs. Ashley. An execution was issued on the

Judgment of the City Court Jan 31/890. and return
nulla bona July 10/90. An alias was is-
sued Sept 18/90 and the said H. R. Ross
paid the full amount of the judgment
rendered against said Mrs Ashby and

all the Costs of the Court. But do not
pay ~~the~~ ^{any} interest. The plenis execution
to collect ~~the~~ interest was issued Oct
1/894 and the motion was made to quash
said plenis execution on the grounds stated in the
motion.

It is further agreed that the fine of the
imposed by the Recorder Court was the full
limit of the Authority given to said Court
to fine violators of the Municipal Ordinances.
The ordinance imposing a penalty of from One
Dollar to One Hundred Dollars. The said
limit is fixed by the Charter of the City of An-
niston.

It is further agreed that Neom Ashby was solvent
at the time that the judgment was rendered against
him and that he has since died & that his estate
is insolvent.

It is further advised that Mrs A. R. Ross ~~was~~
has been continuously absent since the resu-
dation of the judgment in the case.
