In the name of God, amen, I, Gottlob Kienzle of Bridgeton, New Jersey, do make and publish this as my last will and testament.

First: I do order all my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid.

Item: I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife Caroline R. for and during her natural life, all of my estate both real and personal.

Item: After the decease of my said wife Caroline, I do give devise and bequeath all of said real and personal estate to my children Charles, Ann Caroline & Frederick E. to be equally divided between them share and share alike.

Item: I hereby appoint my beloved friend Jacob Kienzle, the executor of this my last will and testament. Witness my hand this ninth day of August Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and seventy four.
