FACTS ARE AS FOLLOWS: Patient states that the right ear began to discharge following swimming, at the age of nine (9), but at present, it discharges only when he gets a cold. There is no fullness or tinnitus present.

Examination shows the right drum to be thickened anteriorly, with a 2 mm. marginal perforation in the post superior quadrant which is quite congested and edematous. The left drum shows some paleness with slight retraction. Hearing in the right ear is 14/15; in the left, 14/15.

It is the opinion of the Board that he should be discharged from the U. S. Naval Service.
