

It shall be the duty of the clergymen, magistrates and other persons who perform the marriage ceremony to keep a registry, of the marriages celebrated by them. \* \* \* \* \* Every person authorized by law to perform the marriage ceremony shall register his or her name and address in the office of the Bureau of Records (Sec. 159, Sanitary Code). \* \* \* \* \* It shall be the duty of every person required to make or keep any such registry, of \* \* \* \* \* person \* \* \* \* \* to present to the Bureau of Records a copy of such registry signed by such \* \* \* \* \* within ten days after the \* \* \* \* \* marriage \* \* \* \* \* which shall thereupon be placed on file in the said Bureau (Sec. 161, Sanitary Code). \* \* \* \* \* N. B.—Sec. 1380, Chap. 462, Laws of 1901, makes the failure to report within ten days, a written copy of the registry of the marriages provided to be registered, a misdemeanor, punishable by fine or imprisonment.
