

DRYS, IN FINAL DRIVE, TO INVADE ALL RANGE TOWNS

**Rev. Father Dunne at Virginia To-day—Week's Schedule Announced.
Both Sides Are Active.**

VIRGINIA, Sept. 2.—The injection of the labor issue into the wet and dry argument, precipitated Thursday by the Virginia Trades assembly, followed by the challenge of the Trades Union Dry league to a debate, has tended to stimulate keen interest in many range quarters. Both sides also are beginning to flood the voters with letters, circulars and other publicity methods calculated to induce the indifferent to get out to vote Sept. 10.

A heavy list of dry speakers for the final week of the campaign has been completed.

Tomorrow the first of a series of meetings to begin promptly at 12:15 p. m., will take place at the Grand theater, with Rev. Father Dunne of Eau Claire as the speaker. Tuesday noon C. J. Hall of California will be speaker; Wednesday, E. E. Lobeck of Long Prairie, a prominent dry advocate well known throughout the state; Thursday noon, Judge Martin Hughes of Hibbing. Friday, Rev. W. H. Farrell and Saturday, T. J. Greer, president of the Louisiana State Federation of Labor will take up the cudgels against the saloon.
