Descendants of Everett Langford, please take note. Here begins a long documented line of medical heart conditions. There are numerous accounts of his descendants having heart attacks in their 30's

Notes

Everett Langford was born on August 12, 1890 in Morgantown, Butler County, Kentucky. He was the youngest of two brothers. Everett's father, Dr. Richard Irvin Langford, died when Everett was only 16 years old. I requested a copy of Everett's Birth Certificate, but the Cabinet for Health Services replied saying that there was none on file. A copy of this response is provided in the Birth Certificate section of this book. This is not uncommon for births prior to 1911.

As a young man, Everett worked with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on a Derrick boat on Green River Lock No. 4. He then returned home and began Farming.

On December 31, 1908, Everett joined the Army at the age of 18. He served in the Army for 3 years. Everett was stationed at Fort Adams, Newport, Rhode Island as shown in the 1910 US Census. On February 15, 1909, Everett was stationed with the 129th Coastal Artillery Corps. I believe he was part of the 5th Company, 1st Artillery District, Coast Artillery Corps. I still need to research more on this with the US Army.

Apparently while Everett was stationed at Fort Adams, the well to do summer residents of Newport protested loudly that the firing of large guns at Fort Adams and Fort Wetherill was quite disturbing to them. United States Senator George

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Peabody Wetmore (himself a Newport summer resident) wrote a letter, dated June 13th, 1910, to Mr. John T. Spencer, Esquire informing him that there would be no firing of the large guns at Forts Adams and Wetherill with service (i.e., full) charges during the summer months. (Source: Newport Daily News, June 14th, 1910.)

Everett Langford was Honorably discharged from the Army on December 30, 1911. Everett married Lela Dever Ranney on April 28, 1912 in Ohio County.

Like most of the men who lived in this era and locale, Everett started working in the coal mines. He then became a Check Wayman for the Holt Brother's Coal Company. The Holt Brother's Mining Company was located in Clanton, McHenry, Ohio County, Kentucky. It had approximately 250 employees and was in operation from 1921-1938. A check Wayman is the person who is responsible for weighing the coal before it is shipped out by the company. The Check Waymen were elected by the mining union members to act as a check and balance system against companies. A man's wages were determined by the weight of coal he mined, so it was important to protect the miners from being taken advantage of. Everett was a check weighman for approximately 13 years. After leaving the coal mines, he began his long career in public service.

Everett became the Chief of Police for the City of Beaver Dam, Kentucky and served the city for approximately 12 years. Everett later served as the Ohio County Circuit Court Clerk for 4 years. He then ran for office of the Sheriff of Ohio County, Kentucky and was elected on the Republican Ticket. He served as the county Sheriff from 1950-1964.

It is interesting to note that Everett Langford is the enumerator on the census dated April 28, 1930. (Enumeration District: 92-11, Supervisor's District: 6) for Rockport, Ohio County, Kentucky.

He was a member of the Beaver Dam Christian Church.

CENSUS RESEARCH NOTE: The 1900 census shows Everett and his family living next door to one of the Ranney Families. I need to follow-up more on this. The neighboring family is Charles W. Ranney, an Uncle of Lela Dever. Lela is currently 8 years old living in Butler County in the 1900 census. The Arbuckle family lives about 3 houses away too. Flora Arbuckle married Thomas Campbell Hosey, a step-brother of Everett.

Everett Ranney Langford was born on December 25, 1925 in McHenry, Ohio County, Kentucky. My Grandfather Everett was the youngest (living) child of Everett Langford and Lela Dever Ranney. Most of his friends and family called him "Ranney". I always knew him simply as, "Papaw," which is what my Mom and her cousin's called their grandfather.

Everett Ranney Langford closely followed the career footsteps of his Father, Everett Langford. He began by working as a coal miner, followed by serving his country in the Military, followed by a very long career in law enforcement.

During WW II, Everett served his country in the U.S. Navy from November 2, 1943 to January 23, 1946. He went to boot camp in Great Lakes, Illinois. He served aboard the USS LST-691 and USS LST- 1140. An LST (Landing Ship Tank) is an amphibious assault ship that lands onto beach heads and allows troops, tanks, and other equipment to roll right onto the beach. He did deployments on both the East and West Coast. Everett left the USN as an SM2 (Signalman Second Class Petty Officer), pay grade E-5. He became a shell back on July 3, 1945 when he crossed the equator. Shell back is a long standing tradition in the Navy. His shell back certificate was passed onto his grandson Jeffrey (also a shell back) when he passed away. While in the Armed Forces, Everett was awarded the following decorations: American Theater Campaign, Asiatic-Pacific Theatre Ribbon, European Theatre (1 star), and the Victory Medal.

My grandfather was a Deputy Sheriff in Ohio County, Kentucky between 1950 and 1954. This was during the term that his father, Everett Langford, was the elected Ohio County, Kentucky Sheriff. Everett began his service with the U.S. Marshall Service on July 29, 1954. After 23 years of service, he retired on July 29, 1977. My grandfather Everett's service included Western Kentucky and Oregon. He started a small security business called RAMS (Ranney and Margaret) Specialized Security Service.

Everett enjoyed gambling and playing poker regularly for entertainment. He also loved being with his grandchildren, Jeffrey and Jennifer. His grandson Jeffrey recalls 2 great memories of time with his grandfather. While Everett was still in the U.S. Marshall Service, he locked Jeff up in a cell for fun. Everett also used to rough-house and wrestle with Jeff too. The end result was always the same. Jeffrey always lost, usually in some sort of prisoner incarceration maneuver. Everett passed away almost 1 year after his Wife Margaret died.

Everett was a member of the Beaver Dam Masonic Lodge No. 420 (F&AM), Elks Lodge No. 42 and the Scottish Rites at Portland, Alabama Kader Shrine and Alabama Kader Provo Staff. He was also a member of the Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police, National Association of Retired Federal Employees and the Honorable Kentucky Colonels
