

Biography of George & Mary Ann (Cook) Newark of Lincolnshire, England

George Newark was a miller born in Lincolnshire England in 1790 and one of the family of five children of George and Sarah Newark. In 1821, at the age of 30, he married a 24 year-old Lincolnshire lass named Mary Ann Cook. Together they had ten children, three boys named Frederick, Job and Joseph and seven girls, Georgiana, Mary, Esther, Rebecca, Tirzah (who died aged 2 years) and Naomi who were all born in Lincolnshire, England and Sarah Ann who was born in Victor, Ontario County, NY. George and his brother William, also a miller, joined a tide of British emigrants to North America. Leaving from Liverpool, England they arrived together at New York aboard the *Sylvanus Jenkins* on July 8, 1835 and travelled to Farmington, Ontario County, NY. In 1836 George promptly signed his declaration of intent to become an American citizen while William waited until 1840 to sign his.

Mary (Cook) Newark followed her husband to the USA nearly four years later, presumably after he had time to establish himself. On June 6, 1839 she and their eight English children arrived in New York aboard the ship *Brunswick* from Hull, England where the family was reunited in Farmington. The following year, 1840, George took the oath of allegiance to become a naturalized US citizen and as was then the practice, naturalization was automatically conferred upon his wife Mary and their children. George's brother William took his oath in Farmington in 1844. For thirty years, George and Mary lived in Farmington, NY until George died about 1866 at age 76. His widow Mary remained there until old age caught up to her and she moved sometime between 1870 and 1880 to live with her married daughter Esther (Newark) Pollard in Allegan, MI. Esther's husband, William Joseph Pollard was also a miller as were Esther's brothers Frederick Newark and Job E Newark. Mary died in 1886 at 92 years of age in Greene County, Iowa, the home of her daughter Naomi.

At some point the Newark family met another large English emigrant family from Kent named Padgham. The Padghams had arrived in New York April 26, 1851 on the "*Northumberland*". Three of George and Mary's daughters (Georgiana, Mary and Naomi) married Padghams. Another, Rebecca, does not appear to have married. In 1860, at age 29, she was living with her sister Esther in Michigan. Son Job E Newark was twice married to Padghams. Job's first marriage about 1852 was to Elizabeth Padgham in Farmington. They had two boys, Alfred William Newark and Guy Ellsworth Newark and two girls, Ida A Newark and Carrie E Newark and about 1857 resettled themselves in Centerville, MI. Then something happened to Job and Elizabeth's relationship because in 1872 Job and an Anna Elizabeth (Padgam) Herbert had a boy together in Kalamazoo, MI named John Newark. A week after John was born, Job and Anna married. Two years later in 1874, Job's first wife, Elizabeth Padgham also remarried to Emund Stears, a capitalist. Job and Anna went on to have another boy named Guy F Newark and were last mentioned in the 1880 census as living in Pekin, Tazewell, Illinois (the census indicates the head of the household as "John" but this is believed to be a mistake).

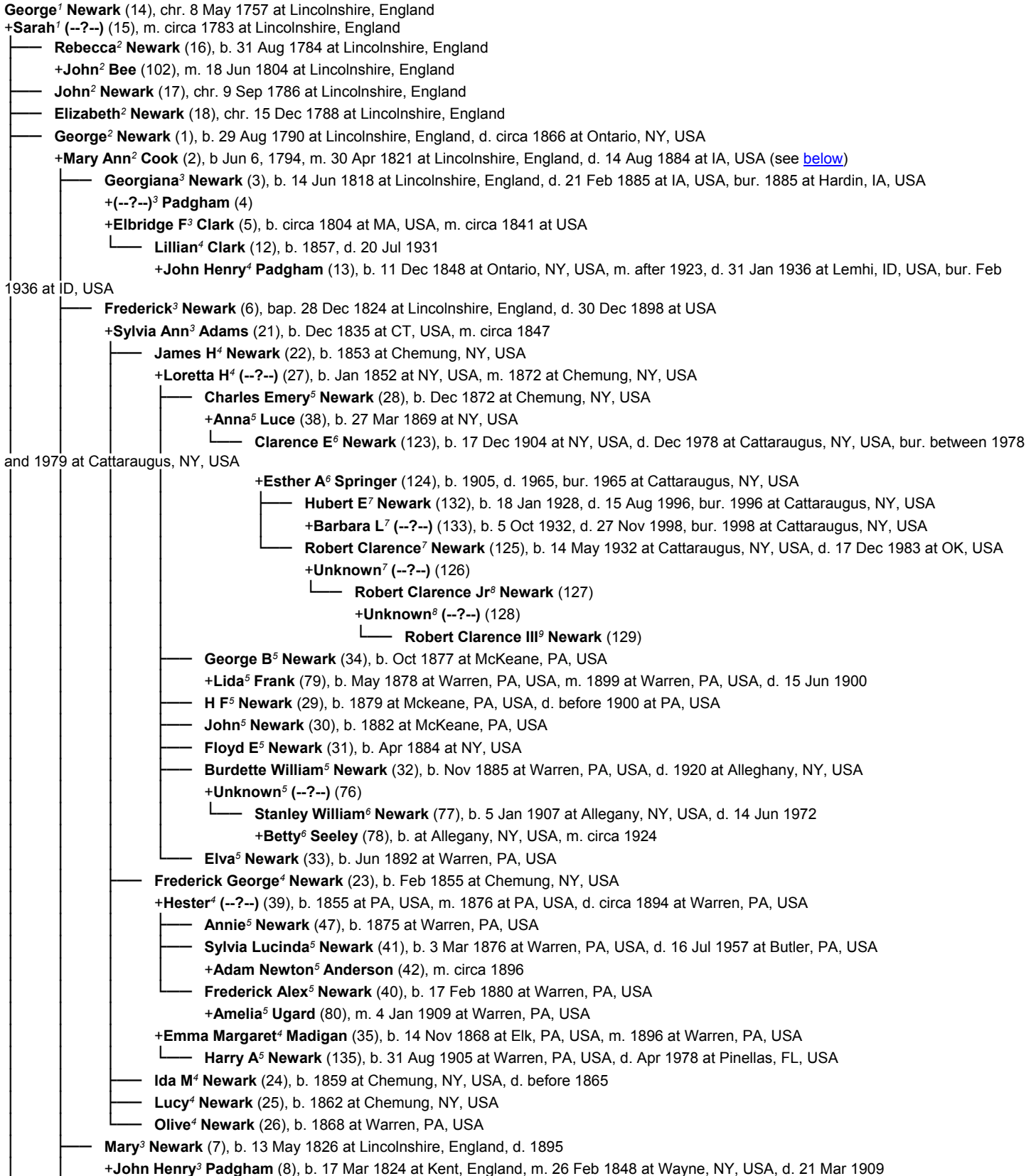
About 1847 George and Mary's other son, Frederick Newark (1824-1898) at age 23 married Sylvia Ann Adams aged 12 years. Frederick and Sylvia moved to Veteran, Chemung County, NY and started their family consisting of two boys, James H Newark and Frederick George Newark, and three girls Ida M, Olive and Lucy. About the time of the Civil War they moved to Kinzua, Warren County, PA. Frederick and Sylvia are known to have living descendants in 2006.

George and Mary Newark were part of a large wave of emigrants to North America in the 1830s. They came from Lincolnshire where the family name of Newark can be found as far back as records go in the 1560s. However they appear to have been among the last of that name in Lincolnshire because following the date of their departure the name Newark can no longer be found in Lincolnshire records (other than those of an unrelated group of Newarks who moved there from Norfolk).

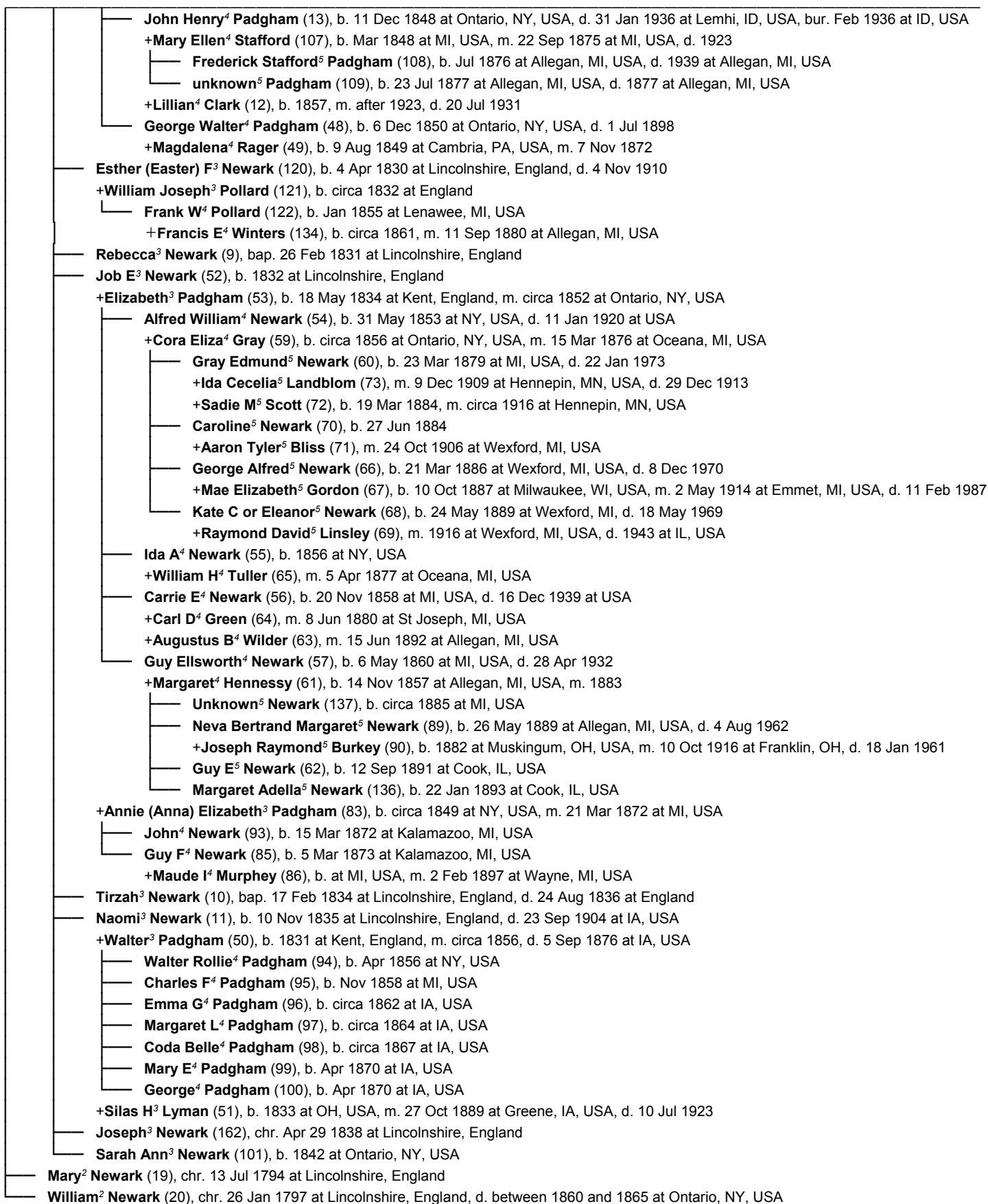
NY and PA Newark families with roots in Lincolnshire, England

He was christened on 2 Sep 1790 at Waddington, Lincolnshire, England. He married **Mary Cook** (2) on 30 Apr 1821 at Alford, Lincolnshire, England. He emigrated July 8, 1835 aboard the *Silvanus Jenkins* from Liverpool, England to New York. From there he went to Ontario, NY, USA (Declaration of intent to become a citizen filed 1836). He was naturalized in 1840 at Ontario, NY, USA (Took the oath of allegiance). He and Mary Cook (2) appeared on the census of 1855 at Farmington, Ontario, NY (Source Ann Tomica, 2005). He died circa 1866 at Farmington, Ontario, NY, USA (In Farmington, Ontario, NY for the 1865 census but not listed in the 1870 census. Surrogate court has records dated 1866).

1. **Georgiana³ Newark** (3) married (---) **Padgham** (4). She was born on 14 Jun 1818 at Louth, Lincolnshire, England. She was baptized on 16 Sep 1821 at Alford, Lincolnshire, England. She emigrated on 6 Jun 1839 from Hull, England to USA (Came with family to America aboard the ship "*Brunswick*" from Hull, England arriving on June 6, 1839). She married **Elbridge F Clark** (5) circa 1841 at USA. She and Elbridge F Clark (5) appeared on the census of 1880 at Buckeye, Hardin, Iowa, USA. She was buried in 1885 at Buckeye Cemetery, Buckeye, Hardin, IA, USA. She died on 21 Feb 1885 at Iowa, USA, at age 66.

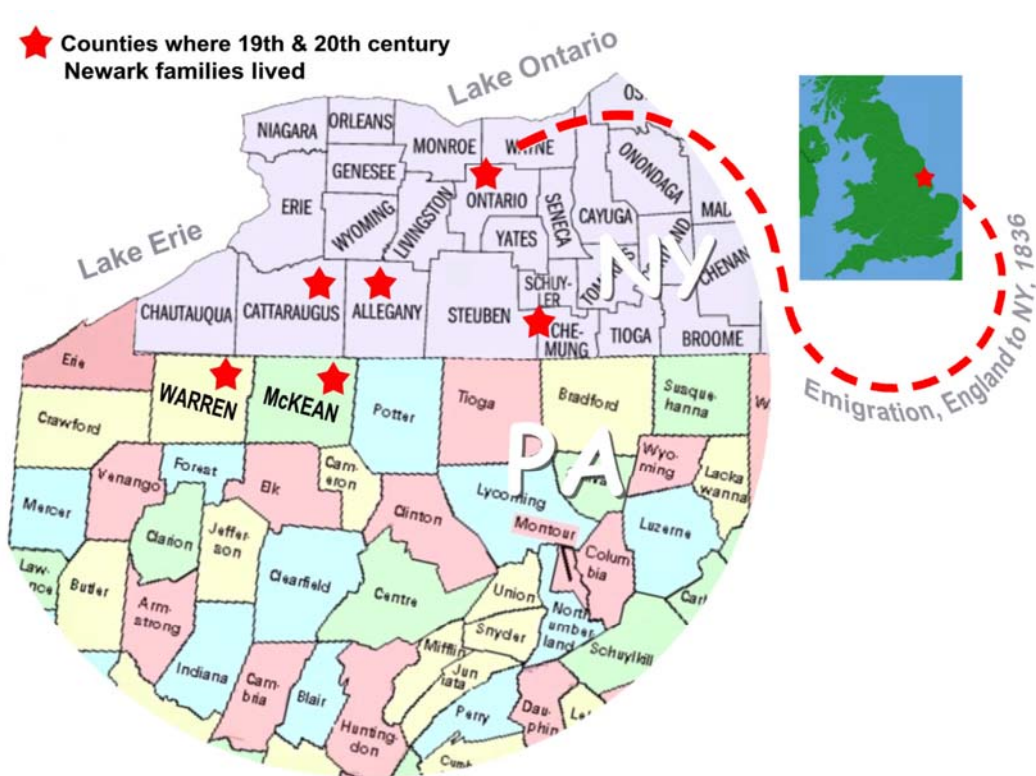

- E. **Mary² Newark** (19) was christened on 13 Jul 1794 at Waddington, Lincolnshire, England (IGI).
- F. **William² Newark** (20) was christened on 26 Jan 1797 at Waddington, Lincolnshire, England (IGI). He emigrated July 8, 1835 aboard the *Silvanus Jenkins* from Liverpool, England to New York. From there he went to Ontario, NY, USA (Declaration of intent to become a citizen filed 1840). He was naturalized in 1844 at Ontario, NY, USA (Took the oath of allegiance). He appeared on the census of 1855 at Farmington, NY, USA. He died between 1860 and 1865 at Farmington, Ontario, NY, USA (In Farmington, Ontario, NY for the 1860 census but not listed in 1865. Surrogate court records for 1869).

p. 4 "Naoma Newark was born in England in the year 1835 and removed with her parents to the state of New York when three years of age. In 1855 she was married to Walter Padgham who died in 1876. Out of this union there were born eight children four of whom had preceded her in death. In 1889 in the month of Oct. Mrs. Padgham was married to Silas Lyman. She having lived in Greene Co. for 28 years, she had formed a large circle of friends and acquaintances many of whom were present at her funeral. She was converted and joined the Methodist church when 24 years of age and lived in that church until the day of her death, which occurred on the morning of the 28th of Sept. 1904. The funeral was held from the residence the afternoon of the 29th. Rev. E.H. Fleisher who had been her pastor for the last two years conducted the services preaching from 2d Cor. 5:1. The interment was in Grand Junction cemetery. She leaves a husband and four children to mourn her death. The children were all permitted to be at the funeral services of their mother.

"Word was received in Junction the first of the week that Mr. Silas Lyman who has been making his home in the Old Peoples Home in Boone (IA) had passed on to the great Beyond. My Lyman was a resident of Junction and vicinity for many years. The funeral will be held this afternoon at the Methodist church and interment made in the Grand Junction cemetery beside those of his wife. We hope to have an old obituary for next week." (none was subsequently found).
