The Newark name in Lincolnshire, England

Many individuals named Newark can be found in the IGI (Church of Later Day Saints) records of christenings, burials and marriages for Lincolnshire (see Table below). A map of the places where these events took place (Map 1) shows two geographical clusters. One main cluster is found in northeastern Lincolnshire and another smaller cluster is seen in the southern portion of the county. An examination of the northern cluster shows the places inhabited by Newarks generally followed the roads forming a triangle from Grimsby to Lincoln to Skegness to Grimsby. In the case of the southern cluster the places are aligned on roads running north and east from Stamford.

In the north the earliest record found (Map 2) is for the year 1565 at Humberston in the vicinity of Grimsby. In general the date is later at each place along the roads radiating out from Grimsby. For example, along the road from Grimsby to Lincoln the date of the earliest record at each place increases from 1565 to 1784. This suggests that Newark families migrated from Grimsby towards Lincoln. A similar southward migration occurred from Grimsby towards Skegness (the 1830 date at Louth was due to a family which moved there from Waddington in the late 1700s). In the southern cluster the earliest record of the name was at Spalding in 1577 and a migration pattern is not evident.

The last date of the last record found in Lincolnshire is 1838 at Louth (Map 3). The family living there emigrated to New York, USA in 1839. At most places Newark records can be found for only short periods of time. Grimsby is a notable exception where records span the 216 year period from 1565 to 1781. The next longest is at Little Bytham and Friskney where records span 38 and 35 years respectively.

Given that there are records missing from the IGI collection, the maps nonetheless suggest fairly clearly that Grimsby was the original source location for the name Newark in northern Lincolnshire. Grimsby was also the location of the longest and most continuous habitation by Newark families in Lincolnshire. The name appears to have spread from there inland towards Lincoln and Skegness. Of course it isn't known how the name arrived at Grimsby, but given its port location and strong trading connections with European countries across the North Sea it raises the possibility that the Newark families of Grimsby were originally immigrants such as Huegenots. Another possibility is that fishing Newarks arrived from Norfolk and Suffolk ports such as Yarmouth, Gorleston and Lowestoft where the name is known to have existed at least as long ago as the early 1600s. This was in fact the route taken around 1850 by the forebears of Newark families who now live in the vicinity of Boston, Lincolnshire.

It isn't known if the Newark families in the southern Lincolnshire cluster were related to those in the northeast. It is possible that they were part of a group stretching eastwards towards Norwich in Norfolk and from there into northern Suffolk.

TABLE LEGEND

Column headed "1" refers to the status of the named individual Newark. F = Female; H = Husband; M = Male; W = Wife.

Column headed 2 refers to the type of recorded event. B = Born; Bu = Burial; C = Christening; M = Marriage;

Whether Parent(s) or Spouse is determined from the type of event. For example if the event is a birth or christening then the name(s) in the fourth column is/are parent(s). If a marriage, then the spouse is named in the fourth column.

Column headed "Fam" shows family groups where they can be determined. The numbers are cross references to rows where there are equivalences. For example, Wm Newark in row 153 has the same parents (Geo. Newark/Sarah) as the individual (Rebec Newark) in row 148. The second number, in this example "154" for Rebec Newark, indicates she is the same individual listed in row 154 who married John Bee. A total of at least 38 family groups have been identified from the data in this Table.
