Myra and her brother David were the last two of the family to live on Montrose Hill. Neither ever married.

Cyrus Blackham

From the 1922 History of Pittsburgh and Its Environs, page 128:

"In the industrial world of Allegheny county, Pa., Cyrus Blackham was prominent for many years, then became identified with public service, in which for twenty years he has held the position of supervisor of O'Hara township."

After a discussion of Mr. Blackham's parents in England, it continues: "Cyrus Blackham was born in Shaffordshire, England, Sept. 22, 1862 and attended schools in his native town until he was ten years of age. At that time, with his mother and older brothers, he came to America to join his father, who was already settled in Harmarville, Allegheny county, Pa. Here he continued his education in the schools of Indiana township, attending until about fourteen years of age. He then entered the world of industry in the employ of the Standard Manufacturing Company, of Pittsburgh. Learning the trade of moulder with this concern, he continued in their employ after completing his apprenticeship until he was twenty-eight years of age. He went to Zelienople, where he was with the Iron City Manufacturing Company for a period of two years. Thereafter, he took up farming, conducting a farm, owned by his wife's people, back of Hoboken in O'Hara township, until 1902. This farm was sold to Allegheny county and is still part of the farm land owned by the county and used in connection with the workhouse, which is situated in what was formerly known as Hoboken and is now the borough of Blawnox. Mr. Blackham has been supervisor of O'Hara township since leaving the farm in 1902, and has a beautiful brick house on the hillside overlooking the Alleghenv river valley in O'Hara township. This residence was erected in 1912, and is one of the beauty spots of the Montrose district, where it is situated.

Politically, Mr. Blackham has always supported the Republican party, and for many years has been a leader on its councils. He served as school director of O'Hara township for years. During the World Was he was one of the most prominent workers in the township in the Red Cross and Salvation Army drives, and also took a leading part in Liberty Load activities. He is a member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of Hoboken, and of Sharpsburg Lodge, knights of Malta. He is a member of the Methodist Episcopal church of Hoboken.

Mr. Blackham married (first), Jan. 1, 1883, in Hoboken, Rennie Burkhart, who was born in Somerset county Pa., in 1862 and died in 1891." After discussing her linage, it continues: "Cyrus and Rennie were the parents of two children: 1. Pearl, born in 1885; married John Pollock; and now, with her daughter Agnes, sixteen years of age, resides with her father {See 1920 Census records.}. 2. Charles, born in 1887; associated with Pure Oil Company, of Pittsburgh, as superintendent of transportation in their yards; resides in Pittsburgh; married Nellie Mellet, and they have three children: Cyrus, Marie and Eva.

Mr. Blackham married (second), in 1893, Emma Boyd, who was born in O'Hara township, June 26, 1862, a daughter of David and Jane (Morrison) Boyd, farming people of that township, both now deceased and buried there in Greenwood cemetery. The only child of the second marriage, David Boyd Blackham, was born in 1896. He enlisted in the World War from Sharpsburg, Pa., was sent to Camp Lee, where he was stationed for fourteen months, the greater part of the time in the recruiting office, and was one of the last to leave the camp after the expiration of the war. Upon receiving his honorable discharge from the service, he returned to the family home where he resides now, and is employed as an officer in the Allegheny County Workhouse, at Hoboken."

As Mrs. Van Horn mentioned in her interview, in the Montrose area, everyone was related to everyone else by the early twentieth century.

The name Duganne appears in several references to the Montrose area, in slightly differing forms.

The 1870 United States Census has an entry of a Peter Duganne, age 39, a white male, born in Virginia and employed as a superintendent at the oil refinery. It gives his wife as Elizabeth, age 33. Also part of the family are seven children as follows: Isabella, age 15, George, age 13, Elizabeth, age 10, Samuel, age 6, Ella, age 4, Maggie, age 2, and William, age 2 months.

An entry in the 1885-6 Diffenbacher Directory of Pittsburgh and Allegheny contains an entry for a Sam'l. M Duganne as a laborer boarding at 35 Seventh. The Samuel Duganne from the 1870 census would be approximately 21 years old in 1885. The 1886-87 directory lists him as "S R" at the same address. Subsequent directories from 1889 throuh 1896 desrcibe him as a painter living at 15 Franklin.

The 1906 map of Montrose shows a Sam'l. Dugan living on River Road {Old Freeport at the time}. The Samuel Duganne from the 1870 census would have been approximately 42 years old at this time.

The 1908 Polk Directory of Pittsburgh lists a Howard Duganne as a bookkeeper living in Hoboken.

The 1918 Polk Directory of Pittsburgh lists a Letitia Duganne as a stenographer living in Hoboken and working for the Pittsburgh Wood Preserving Company.

The 1921 listing of the Red Cross volunteers for the O'Hara Township branch lists both a Miss L. Duganne and a Mrs. S. Duganne as "additional workers".

The subsequent Polk directories list a Letitia Duganne as a stenographer working for several different companies, including the May Lumber Company and the previously mentioned Pittsburgh Wood Preserving Company in the years 1922, 1923, 1925, 1927, 1929 and 1930. Her residence is given alternately as either Blawnox or Glenover.

The 1922 Polk directory lists a S. R. Duganne as a painter at the County Court House with a home in Blawnox. The Samuel Duganne from the 1870 census would have been approximately 58 years old at this time.

Also listed in the Polk directories from 1922, 1923, 1925, 1929 and 1930 is a George Duganne living at 218 Carver. The George from the 1870 census would be 73 years old in 1930.

Additionally, an Ada Duganne, living in Crafton, is listed in the 1923, 1925, 1927, 1929 and 1930 directories.

An Uncertain But Interesting Connection

A series of articles found in the publication of the American armed forces Service News in 1918, may be a connection to the Dugannes of the Montrose / Hoboken area, but this is only speculative. Regardless, this is an interesting insight into what an American nurse was experiencing in France during the First World War. The article is a letter send home to a Miss Duganne. Although the salutation was eliminated by the publishers, they left a reference within the letter itself, as follows:

"SOMEWHERE IN FRANCE.

I received your dainty little Christmas card on Thanksgiving Day, and surely thank you very kindly for it. The mails are not at all dependable, as today I received mail that had been posted in Pittsburgh three weeks before yours was.

I often think of the class of which I was a member, and just wonder what they are doing. As yet we have no Bible study of any kind, but have "great expectations" for many things promised. The Y. W. C. A. hope to establish a canteen here, together with a tent fitted up as a rest room.

We are very comfortably situated here with all the French inconveniences—French windows that open like doors, stoves that smoke continuously and bath roams without any bath tubs, for French people do not have the word "bath" in their creed. You know "France may he long on romance, but it is mighty short on plumbing," and such an article as a rocking-chair is unknown here.

We are very, very busy getting our hospital ready for patients, as we hope by building additions to make it one of two thousand beds. It is a very commodious and beautiful building, just ideal for a hospital. It was formerly used as a boys' school and has several wings built surrounding a court, which contains many beautiful shrubs and flowers. The flowers are still in full bloom and the weather very pleasant, but cool, though we have had no signs of snow as yet. We have some wards fixed up and several patients, but are unable to accommodate very many yet. We nurses all sleep in one large room, like a ward, in the hospital, and, Miss Duganne, if you have not had a practical course in ward life your education is not complete. I am just crazy (?) about it. Such a chattering by day and then snoring by night, and then in the morning when we dress we have about as much privacy as a gold fish in a bowl on the living room table. Then our wardrobes! How I envy fortunate Eve! Oh, easy life when trunks were not, and clothes on bushes grew! I assure you it is a most interesting course, especially if taken in France.

Later I shall write you a brief description of our trip here, as we were over ten weeks on our journey. I will try to also tell something more definite about our work here. I surely appreciate your kind remembrance, and hope to hear from you sometimes, for we get homesick occasionally "Somewhere in France."

Give my best wishes to all for a Merry Christmas, and especially to Mr. Dalzell.

I found no references to any Elliott in the 1900 nor 1910 census records of the area. The 1920 census of the Montrose area contains only one reference to an Elliott family, as follows:

Jacob K. Elliott, a white male age 29, residing with his wife Nelle, age 24. They appear to be located on what is now River Road as are close to Holland in the enumeration.

Two more of Sarah Elliott's letters {that do not appear to have gone to Miss Duganne} are published in the Service News, as follows:

"A BUSY NURSE.
April 9, 1918.
Mv Dear

Received your interesting letter a short time ago and a few days later your Easter card. We suffered quite a bit from cold weather, but it has grown somewhat warmer, but the air is very damp and penetrating and we all wear our sweaters and winter clothing. If the sun shines brightly and the air grows warm we often see bees and beautiful butterflies. The flowers are in full bloom. The air and cold does not seem to affect, them.

Many improvements have been made to our hospital and it is now filled to its capacity. Our beautiful campus is filled with barracks and it looks like a little village. There are several barracks for enlisted men, for nurses, for officers, for patients for receiving patients, a laboratory, a laundry, a mess hail; in all there are now over thirty. So far all of the patients we have received were by rail and by ambulance, but our engineers have constructed or are constructing a railroad which will pass through our yard within twenty feet of the door of the hospital. The French wonderfully equipped Red Cross trains for carrying wounded men from the casualty stations, which are more comfortable than an ambulance. Everything now being hurried forward as quickly as possible. The Mess Hall is the first barracks completed and we had our first meal there a few days ago. It is a long narrow building of one story. Now we have small tables seating six people instead of one long table, a table-cloth and napkins with napkin rings, china dishes and real silver. Before we used tables covered with oil cloth and tin dishes. We use chairs instead of benches, but the chairs are regular French affairs with backs about six inches high, so are not particularly comfortable. Our old mess hall had a stone floor which was always so cold. All of the first floors and often the second floors in the houses in France are made of stone or brick, and many of these people wear wooden shoes or shoes with wooden soles. The roads, too, are very hard.

It is needless to say that I am exceedingly busy from the patients I have now and do not have time to write such a very long letter.

I am enclosing a few snap shots and on the back of each is a short description which I always consider as part of my letter.

I trust you will find time to write, as I always enjoy getting letters though now I am terribly handicapped for time to answer them. Sincerely yours,

"LOYAL TO BOTH OUR COUNTRY AND OUR BOYS
FRANCE, October 7, 1918.
DEAR

I am now living in a little American village somewhere in France. The inhabitants in this village think it superior in every respect in comparison with the French towns nearby. No one could ever imagine he was in a strange land among strange people if lie were to walk through one of its streets for everything is so truly American, all of the inhabitants being American soldiers and nurses, The size of the city varies but is steadily increasing and at the present writing over 3.000 could be comfortably housed and eared for. Buildings are still in course of construction and naturally the population will increase as soon as these buildings are finished.

The interior of the old monastery of which I spoke in a previous letter has been remodeled until in a great measure it resembles an American hospital. A number of barracks radiate from this building all lighted with electricity and equipped with hot and cold water, and filled with hundreds of little white beds. No doubt you have guessed the town I am describing, is our own Base Hospital No. 27. A Red Cross train comes into our midst filled with wounded soldiers and for a time we seem almost overwhelmed, every available bed is soon filled with wounded soldiers, many of which are very close to eternity, and yet all are happy, because they can rest in a real bed, get nourishing food, and good care, and best of all, talk with someone in their own tongue. The poet has beautifully said they are always smiling over here and the statement seems to be correct:

"Always smiling, come good or ill. Into the battle's smoke and noise; Facing death they are smiling still— Our glorious Yankee boys."

I can only reiterate a former statement that I am more convinced every day that there is no country in all the world like our incomparable U. S. A. and our boys—aren't they glorious?

I often am depressed with the suffering around me, yet I am happy that I am privileged to have even a small part in relieving the pains of those who, with no choice and hesitation, went forth to meet duty fearlessly and bravely on the field of battle.

Various Other People from the Montrose and Hoboken Area

Eiffler

An entry in the 1889-90 Diffenbacher Directory of Pittsburgh and Allegheny lists a John C. Eiffler as an engineer living at 166 Third in Allegheny.

A Jno. C. Eiffler shows up in the 1891-92 1st Annual Report of the Department of Public Safety of the City of Allegheny as an Engineer with the Engine Company Number 1, located on Martin Street. His age is listed as 24 years. {This would infer a birth year of approximately 1867.} His residence is given as 166 Third Street. His appointment date is Oct. 14, '82, which means that he was with the fire company for about 9 years, starting at the age of 14 or 15. He is again listed in the 2nd Annual Report of 1893 as John Eiffler, Engineer, 26 years old, same residence, but with an appointment date of Nov. 2, '90. {Perhaps his earlier date indicated that he was too young when appointed and someone decided to "fix" the situation.} The 1896-97 report also lists him, this time as John C. Eiffler, Engineer, living at 93 Corry Street, but now with an appointment date of Nov. 7, 1891.

The 1899 Polk Directory of Pittsburgh & Allegheny lists a John Eiffler as a machinist living at 37 2nd {Street} in the City of Allegheny.

The 1900 census lists a John Eiffler in the Montrose area as a white male, born May of 1866, married 16 years, born in Pennsylvania, parents born in Germany, occupation machinist. His wife is Mary, born in September of 1862. It also lists a son, John, born in July of 1896.

The 1910 census lists John C Eiffler as a white male, age 42, married 16 years, born in Pennsylvania, parents born in Germany, occupation machinist. His wife is Mary, age 41. It also lists one son, 13 year old John H.

Mrs. Van Horn, in her interview, mentions John Eiffler, as follows:

Q: What about Eiffler? Now, I have a John, 42, his wife Mary, and a son John H. that was your age, 13.

<u>A:</u> Oh, (Laughs) yes. Now wait I have to think. The house is there yet. It's down on Freeport Road. On the right hand side {heading into Blawnox from Montrose} there's a white house and then that's where John Eiffler lived.

The 1920 census reports the younger John as the family head. John H. Eiffler is listed as 23 years old, his wife Harriett M. as 18 years old. His father, John C., is listed as 56 years old and residing with them.

Gordon

The 1904 publication "Memoirs of Allegheny County Pennsylvania, Vol. II, contains a biographical entry {page 485} for one Ezekiel Gordon, Jr., as follows:

"Ezekiel Gordon, Jr., of River View, Pa., a well known contractor on the river, was born on July 23, 1859, in Fairview, now called Montrose, O'Hara Township, Allegheny Co., Pa., son of Capt. Ezekiel and Isabella (Hulings) Gordon. Young Gordon attended the common schools in O'Hara Township, of Kiskiminetas township, of Armstrong county, and of Harmarville, and when seventeen years of age left school and began to assist his father, who was a steamboat contractor. When he attained his majority, he secured a position as a steel melter with the Cresent

steel company, of Pittsburg, Pa., and continued with this company until 1891, when he removed to Whitehall, Allegheny county and engaged in the hotel business. He prospered there until 1898, when he bought the hotel in Montrose formerly owned by his father, and conducted the same very successfully until January, 1903, when de disposed of it, and since has been contracting on the river with his steamboat, the "Charles Turner." He is married, on July 20, 1886, to Jane, daughter of James S. and Eleanor (Marshall) Powers, of Turtle Creek, Pa., the former having served as justice of the peace for twenty years. His father, Ezekiel Gordon, was for three years in the employment of the government as steamboat captain, the battle of Monmouth was fought on his great-grandfather's farm, and his mother's grandfather, Samuel Hulings, was among the pioneer settlers of Allegheny county. Samuel Hulings and his wife experienced many phases of the hardships that confront the pioneer, and they had numerous fights with the Indians while preparing the way for the high state of civilization which Allegheny county now enjoys. Mr. Gordon is on of the leading men of that part of Allegheny county, and is well and favorably known." Mr. Ezeliel Gordon, Jr. would have 45 years old when this article was written.

The 1900 census of the Montrose area shows an Ezekiel Gordon as a white male, born July of 1859, married for 14 years. His wife is listed as Jennie, a white female, born March of 1864, and having never had children. The record also shows three boarders at the hotel, a bartender and three servants. The bartender's full name is not readable, but he was a single 28 year old black man. The three servants include one Franklin Bert {probably from Hoboken as that name occurs in the that town regularly.}, born in February of 1872, a single white male; a Mary Hopkins, born in February of 1858, a widowed white female; and a Bessie Asdale, born in July of 1879, a single white female {part of the Asdale family of Montrose Hill}.

Also, the 1900 census of the Montrose area shows his mother, Isabel Gordon, as a white female, born March, 1830, age 70, widowed, having given birth to three children, only one of which survived. She has a servant, 24 year old Lydia Asdale, living with her {part of the Asdale family of Montrose Hill}.

Gunderman

The 1900 Polk & Dudley's Pittsburgh, Allegheny City and Allegheny County Business Directory lists, under Sharpsburg Hotels, John Gunderman at 900 Main Street.

The 1910 census of the Montrose area contains a listing that obviously is the family, staff and guests of the Gunderman Hotel, located on River Road as per Mrs. Van Horn and bought from Ezekiel Gordon in 1903 }see above), as follows: John Gunderman, white male, 45 years old, married 11 years, hotel owner; Amber S., his wife, a white female, age 32; Donald, a son, age 10 years; Nioma, a daughter, age 7; Ruth, a daughter, age 5; Gene, a daughter, age 1.5. Also, there were three servants listed, all white female, as follows: Ella Alson, age 36; Minnie Fris, age 21; Antonia Kunson, age 39. There were also three other employs of the hotel: William Garden, a porter, age 44; Horace Marshall, a hostler, age 24; John H. Seber, a bartender, age 33. All were single white males. Three boarders were also enumerated as at the hotel.

The 1920 census does not contain any reference to the Gunderman family.

Various Other People from the Montrose and Hoboken Area

Holland

There are several entries in the Pittsburgh directories related to the Steward Holland Company, makers of wire fences. The 1915, 1921, 1926 and 1927 edition list Clyde L. Holland as variously the president manager or president-treasurer and M. H. McLean as either the vice president or the secretary. Their office was in the Wabash Building in each listing.

The 1920 Census lists a Clyde L. Holland living on River Road as a white male, 42 years old, owning his home freely, married and was born in West Virginia. Also listed was his wife Catherine E., a white female, age 33.

In her interview, Mrs. Van Horn mentions Mr. Holland as the owner of the land where Shaffer { formerly Kensington} Park is now located and the person responsible for the reservoir that was once on that location.

Hulings

As noted in the entry under "Gordon", above: "Samuel Hulings, was among the pioneer settlers of Allegheny county. Samuel Hulings and his wife experienced many phases of the hardships that confront the pioneer, and they had numerous fights with the Indians while preparing the way for the high state of civilization which Allegheny county now enjoys."

The name Hulings appears on several of the old maps, starting with the 1862 map which shows an S. D, Hullings as located on Freeport Road a half mile or so north of Powers Run. A Mrs. Hullings is also located on Freeport Road {now River Road}. Although the 1855 map does not show a Hulligs, it does show a tavern at exactly the same location as where S. D. Hulings is located later.

A special sidebar is presented in the 2008 O'Hara Township history about the Hulings.

Jessup

The 1858-1859 Directory of Pittsburgh and Vicinity contains an advertisement on page 16 for the Farmer's Union Insurance Company. The advertisement lists some references for the product, including one Honorable William Jessup of Montrose Pa. This Montrose would have to have been the county seat of Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania as the village of Fairview had not yet changed its name.

The 1855 map indicates a Mrs. Jessup living at Fairview.

The 1900 census lists a Charles Jessup, age 17, living with his uncle, Charles Hertzel, age 35. Ten years later, Charles Jessup is listed as a boarder with the same family, minus the uncle.

Hoboken, later Blawnox, was a sister town to Fairview/Montrose throughout the history of both towns. A specific chapter on this town is not included in the main body of this work. The reason was not an intention to ignore the town of Hoboken, which is mentioned on numerous occasions, but rather to acknowledge the fact that Hoboken/Blawnox is a separate entity that has its own history. In fact, there are two books written on the history of Blawnox, one during its 50th anniversary in 1975 and an update printed at the 75th anniversary in 2000. As this author suggested with the O'Hara history book, if the reader is interested in Blawnox history, the reader should read these works first.

Hoboken separated from O'Hara Township in 1925, becoming a borough and taking with it a sizable section of land from Cable Avenue to the east that was previously considered part of Montrose. Because of that annexation, there were many people whose identity was confused. It was not uncommon for people living in the border streets to, from time to time; identify themselves as residing in either Montrose or Blawnox or even Fairview.

Since there is an inherent tie between the two towns based on proximity and shared community and since my investigation of Fairview / Montrose netted a great deal of information of residents and businesses of Hoboken / Blawnox, I have decided to add this addendum to document this information. This section is not meant to be a history of Hoboken / Blawnox, but rather to just present the various pieces of information concerning that town that I stumbled upon while researching Fairview / Montrose.

Hugh Simon

The 1904 publication "Memoirs of Allegheny County Pennsylvania, Volume II", contains the following entry on page 387:

"HUGH SIMONS, of Hoboken, Pa., a well known river contractor, was born in Pittsburg, Pa., Sept. i6, 1845, son of William and Mary (Ireland) Simons, his father being a contractor on the river. Hugh Simons attended the public schools of his native city, and when sixteen years of age began with his father on the river, where he continued until he attained his majority. Then, his father having purchased a farm in Westmoreland county, they removed to this farm and there remained until 1878, when he returned to Pittsburg and entered the employ of O. Scaife in ironroofing work. He continued in that capacity for one year and then returned to Westmorland county, where he was engaged in farming for the next seven years. He then removed to Hoboken and was in the employ of the Allegheny county workhouse until 1893, when the state prohibited the making of barrels by penal institutions, and as that was his business, he was forced to retire. He then engaged in contracting on the river and has prospered in that occupation to the present time. He was married, in 1867, to Mary L., daughter of Henry F. and Margaret Bergman, both natives of Germany. Mr. and Mrs. Simons have eight children, viz.: Frank W., an undertaker, of Allegheny city; Hattie Blanche, wife of Samuel M. Kier, a steel melter, of Aspinwall; Clyde A., auditor of the American mirror plate company, of Pittshurg; Margaret, wife of Frank F. Morrison, a farmer, of Westmoreland county; Algy Warren, a carpenter, of Montrose; Della M.; Allen N., learning the undertaking business with his brother Frank in Allegheny city; Dallas Alton, attending the public schools. Mr. Simons is a member of the Methodist church of Hoboken, the Junior Order of United American Mechanics, the river improvement association and of the republican party. He has served several times on the election board, and in 1903 was elected a justice of the peace for the term of five years."

Riverboating

The 1871 publication "The Allegheny River" contains several references to Hoboken, as follows:

"Until the late 70's, the boating of stone was a flourishing business in the Allegheny Valley. Among those engaged in it at that time or at an earlier date, there may be named the following: Peter Smith, Jacob Moore, and John and George Coffman, of Clinton; Michael, John and Anthony Decker, who lived on Puckety Creek, near the present Parnassus; Hugh, John, and George Simon, who lived just below Nadine; Daniel Jackson, an Irishman, whose home was in Pittsburgh; Mr. Klinefelter, of Sharpsburg; Mr. Jones and sons, of Hoboken; the Pearsoll brothers, who resided near the Simons, below Nadine; Henry Bigler, of Logan's Ferry, whose son engaged in this business later; the brothers, W. K., J. P., John S., T. P., H. P., and James M. Hudson, of Armstrong County; E. J. and Harry B Hulings; Captain Daniel J. Fry and his son, Craig, and numerous others. Among the guipers enrolled at the Custom House, Pittsburgh, in 1877, were those operated by E. J. and H. B. Hulings, the Boss No. 2, the Keystone No. 2, and these boats were still in use in 1879 as well as another, the E. J. Hulings. Anthony Decker was commander of the guiper Decker Brothers, in 1877; Captain Daniel J. Fry, of the guiper D. J. Fry No. I, and Captain T. P. Hudson of the guiper Hudson Brothers No. 4, in 1879."

Also, from the same publication

Smith, Nelson

The 1922 publication of "Pittsburgh and its Environs" contains the following entry on page 155:

"NELSON O. SMITH—Broadly active throughout his career in various branches of industrial endeavor. and always alert to the progress of the times in every phase of human effort, Nelson O. Smith, of Blawnox, Allegheny county, Pa., is now efficiently serving the community as postmaster. Mr. Smith is a son of George Smith, who was horn in Punxsutawney, Jefferson county, Pa., in t8s, where he worked as farmer and lumberman, also as stone mason, all Ida life. In the course of his business he ran rafts of lumber from Punxsutawney to Pittsburgh on the Mahoning and Allegheny rivers, residing In Punxsutawney all his life. The mother, who was born in Indiana county near the Jefferson county line, on a farm, in 1849, still resides in Punxsutawney. They were the parents of fifteen children: Catherine, Theofolis, Philip, George, Edward, Emanuel, Thomas, Nelsen O., of whom further; Lyman and Aaron, twins; William, Samuel, Minnie, Eva and Elizabeth.

Nelson O. Smith, eighth child and seventh son of this family, was born near Punxsutawney, in Jefferson county, June 5, 1879. His school attendance was limited to the opportunities of the public schools of his native county, and ended at the age of twelve years. Later in life he supplemented this meagre preparation for the responsibilities of life by much evening study, and also took correspondence courses with the International Correspondence School, of Scranton, Pa., and the Bush Motor Company, of Chicago Ill. Mr. Smith's first employment, as a boy of twelve, was on the farm in summer and in the lumber camps in winter, and he worked thus until he was eighteen years of age. At that time he secured a position with the steam laundry in Reynoldsville, where he worked for three years, then accepted a better position an clerk in a furniture and hardware store in the same town. He continued in this connection for seven years, serving for five years as clerk, then for two years holding the position of manager. Resigning from this position,

he next went into the transfer business for himself in Reynoldsville, and followed this line of activity for three years, after which, for two years, he demonstrated a new coal-cutting machine, working through Indiana, Ohio, West Virginia, and Pennsylvania His next position was in the employ of the Blaw-Knox Company, at Reynoldsville, where he learned the machinist's trade When that concern removed their works to Hoboken, Pa., in 1912, he was one of the group of employees who remained with the plant, and for four years he made his home in Hoboken. Thereafter, he became connected with the Heppenstall Forge and Knife Company, of Pittsburgh, as machinist, and when the World War broke out he was placed in charge of the plant, under the Ordnance Department of the United States Government, to equip the plant for making guns of different kinds. Later he went to the Edgewater Steel Company, at Verona, Pa., where he was in charge of the gun department for twenty months, and after the signing of the Armistice, took charge of the tool room, later filling a position with the Lange Motor Truck Company, of Pittsburgh. Mr. Smith was appointed postmaster of Blawnox on June 5, 1920, and is now filling that exacting position to the eminent satisfaction of all concerned.

Politically, Mr. Smith has always supported the Republican party. He is a member of Hoboken Lodge, Independent Order of Odd Fellows; and of Zeradatha Lodge, No. 448, Free and Accepted Masons, of Sharpsburg, Pa. Both Mr. Smith and his family are members of the Methodist Episcopal church of Blawnox.

On Oct. 18, 1905, at Brookville, Jefferson county, Pa., Mr. Smith married Susie White, who was born in Reynoldsville, in the same county, and is a daughter of William G. White. Mr. White was born in England and came to America at the age of thirty years, locating In Brownsville, Pa., where he worked for tinny years as a coal miner. He now resides in Barnesboro, Cambria county, Pa. He married Belinda Bennett, who was born is England, and came with her husband to the United States. She died in Reynoldsville, in 1892.

Mr. and Mrs. Smith have two daughters: Wilhelmina, born Aug.31, 1906, in Reynoldsville; and Mildred, burn July 28, 1908, also in Reynoldsville. Mrs. Smith and her daughters are popular in the social circles of Blawnox, and active in the benevolent and social interests of the Methodist church."

Repine

The 1917 Polks Directory of Pittsburgh contains the following entry: "Repine, Parker R., clk, PRR, h Hoboken Pa." The 1918, 1919, 1920 and 1928 versions of this directory have identical entries.

Census Records

The various United States Census Record already presented contain various entries for residents of Hoboken, as follows:

Regarding the records presented from the 1900 census, numbers 17 through 136 seem to cover Hoboken. However, these records were not delineated by village and street and do not appear to have been enumerated in a strict order. These may be some non-Hoboken residents intermixed and some stray Hoboken residents mixed with other areas of eastern O'Hara Township. Specific documentable cases are noted.

Regarding the records presented from the 1910 census, none seem to cover Hoboken.

Regarding the records presented from the 1920 census, only a few streets, which are noted in the enumeration, cover parts of Hoboken.

The Blaw-Knox Company

As the entry regarding Nelson O. Smith, above, states, the Blaw-Knox company relaocated to Hoboken in 1912.

The 1932 publication "Pittsburgh of today: its resources and people, Vol. 2" by Frank C.Harper, contains the following entry covering the Blaw-Knox Company:

"Blaw-Knox Company.—P. O. Box 915, Pittsburgh. Plant at Blawnox. eight miles from Pittsburgh. Capital stock 1,500,000 shares of common, of which 1,309,436 shares are issued. Albert C. Lehman, President; Irvin F. Lehman, F. M. Bowman, Frank Cordes, Vice-Presidents; Wayne Rawley, Vice-President and General Superintendent; Chester H. Lehman, Secretary and General Sales Manager; Benjamin L. Hirshfield, Treasurer. The company manufactures steel forms for concrete, steel transmission towers, poles and radio towers, forge and hammer welding, etc. Besides the plant at Blawnox it has one at Baltimore, Md., and owns the A. V. French Co. of Chicago, Ill., as well as the Lewis Foundry & Machine Co., the Pittsburgh Rolls Corporation, the National Alloy Steel Company and the Union Steel Casting Company."
