office of the Court of Pleas under
the Act of the 5 June 1832, that
by said Act she was entitled to
the Pension List Roll of the NC
Agency at the rate of Twenty five
Dollars, and thirty three Cents per
month
She further declares that
she was married to her Husband
the said William Bragg on
the 4th day of July 1833 before
David Lester Justice of the
Peace in and for the County
of Burke of State of N. C. and
that her name before her said
marriage was Nancy Coffey

that her Husband the said
Wm. Wragg died in the County
of Barker on the 20th
Oct 1847. for proof of which
as well as of their marriage
she refers to her marriage
certificate on file in the Registry
office under 2^d section of
the Act Feb 3^d/53 by which
said Act she is now re-
paying a Person as Wm.
of the said Wm. Wragg
being a Minor at the time
She makes this Decla-
ration for the purpose of
obtaining the Bounty land
to which she may be en-
titled under act of Con-
gress approved 3^d March
1855.
