was a Soldier of the Revolutionary  
War and served in the Charac-  
ter and Capacity stated by him in  
a Declaration now on file in the  
office of the Court of Pleas and  
Sessions under Act of the 7<sup>th</sup> June 1832. that  
by said Act he was recruited on  
the Pension List Roll of the N.C.  
Agency at the rate of Sixty three  
dollars and thirty three Cents per An-  
num. She further declares that  
she was married to her Husband  
the said William Wagg on  
the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 1837 by the  
said Justice of the Peace of the  
County of Duke of State of N.C. and  
that her name before her said  
marriage was Nancy Coffey

that her Husband the said  
Wm Wagg did in the Coun-  
ty of Burke on the 20<sup>th</sup>  
Decr 1847. for proof of which  
as well as of their marriage  
she refers to her own Dece-  
dation on file in the Pension  
office under 2<sup>d</sup> section of  
the Act Febry 3<sup>d</sup> 53 by which  
said Act she is now re-  
ceiving a Pension as Widow  
of the said Wm Wagg  
being a Widow at this time  
She makes this Dece-  
dation for the purpose of  
obtaining the Bounty land  
to which she may be en-  
titled under Act of Con-  
gress approved 3<sup>d</sup> March  
1855.
