On this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1853 personally appeared in open Court at Raleigh Wm. Wragg a Resident of B. County aged 40 years who being duly sworn according to Law doth make oath & make the following Declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provisions of the Act of Congress passed the 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1853

- That she is the Widow of William Wragg who was a Pensioner of the United States under the Act of 7 June 1832 that the said Wragg resided in Burke County N.C. and was a Pensioner of Seventy three  $33/100$  Dollars which said Pension was payable at the Agency for paying Pensions in Fayetteville etc.

She further states that she was married to the said Wm. Wragg on or about the 24<sup>th</sup> July 1837 that her husband the said William Wragg died on the 20<sup>th</sup> Oct

1847 and that she was married  
to her said husband at the time  
above stated

She further deposes that she  
was a widow at the passage of  
the Act and that she is still a  
widow and that she has never  
before made application for a  
Pension

The Court doth hereby certify that it has been  
proven to the satisfaction of the Court that Nancy  
Wagg the declarant is the widow of William  
Wagg who was a Revolutionary Pensioner of the  
United States at the rate of \$33.33 per annum  
and died in Beaufort County in the fall of 1847  
and that she is still a widow and has not  
intermarried since the death of her husband  
also that she is a credible person
