

Cedar Hill to Get Own Newspaper

E. D. Balcom, Dallas businessman and Cedar Hill's most vocal booster, had the promise Saturday of a longstanding wish: Cedar Hill will have a newspaper of its own.

At his estate near the small southwestern Dallas County municipality, Balcom learned that Paul Tonsing, publisher of the News at Mansfield, Tarrant County, fifteen miles to the west, had agreed to launch a weekly publication on Feb. 28.

The first and second issues will go free to 750 families with the blessings of the Cedar Hill Progressive Club, Tonsing's allies in the venture.

For a while the publication will be printed at Mansfield but a Cedar Hill office with Bob Stinson in charge will be opened.

The new paper's name, appropriately enough, will be: The Cedar Post.
