P. Vance and Roxie Vance, his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following lands lying in the County of Saline and State of Arkansas. to-wit:

The South Half of the Northwest Quarter, of Section 22,

Township One South, Range 17 West, containing 80 acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said R. P. Vance and Roxie Vance, his wife, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And we hereby covenant with the said R. P.
