Resident of Solebury, Bucks county, Pa. Will of Thomas probated September 2, 1805, and recorded at Doylestown, Bucks county, in Book 7, page 95. By the will of his uncle in 1750, Thomas took "that plantation at Buckingham, in Bucks county, Pa., that William Preston did clear out of the woods." He was born at Byberry, a township of old Philadelphia county, on a farm bounded by the lines of Bucks county and Montgomery county. By the will of his mother, Mary (Groom) Cooper, Thomas took, in 1722, the remaining 12 acres of her estate, near the site of the hamlet of Smithfield, since called Somerton, now in the most modern ward of Philadelphia city. The hamlet is mentioned at pages 47 and 56 of Martindale's History of Byberry and Moreland.

Cooper, esquire, of this city, after a short illness, in the ninety-seventh year of his age, having been born in Bucks county, Pennsylvania, on the 6th of March, 1753. He was a brother of the late Judge William Cooper, and uncle of James Fenimore Cooper. Till within a few days Mr. Cooper retained in a remarkable degree the powers and faculties of an athletic frame and strong intellect. Captain John Bruce

Captain John Bruce was born in Holland and came to America with his parents when a small boy, and located in Pennsylvania. The Bruces remained in Pennsylvania but a short time, and then removed to Loudoun County, Virginia when John was still quite young. At the breaking out of the Revolutionary War, Mr. Bruce enlisted as a soldier and was appointed Captain and served under General Francis Marion. Captain Bruce saw a great deal of hard fighting during the American struggle for liberty. Captain Bruce's old sword which he carried through the war is still in existence. When an old man, he gave it to his grandson and asked that he never allow it to be dishonored. After he had presented it to his grandson, he said "That sword went through the whole war and was always in the heat of battle". That sword, he said, "cleft the scull of an Indian Chief, and wounded a Tory so he became an easy prisoner".

“Take it and keep it as a sacred memento is your Grandfather’s last request.”

Captain John Bruce married Susan Cooper, sister of the late Judge William Cooper of Cooperstown, New York. The Cooper Family were natives of Virginia. Capt. Bruce had an issue of seven Children, Four sons and three daughters. His sons were Abner, Aaron, John Jr., and David. His daughters’ names were Betsey, Susan, and Letiecia.

He came to Otsego County from Virginia about 1798 and located near the town line between Milford and Laurens. He remained on the same farm until his death.

Judge Cooper was anxious to have Captain Bruce come to this country, and as an inducement, he made him a present of the above named farm which he accepted with many thanks. His son David married Ruth Baker, and located near Edson Corners, was the parent of three children: one son and two daughters:
