Notes for Mary Sander:

Mary's obituary (1928) provided the first evidence of the identities of her five daughters and her son William Franz, the latter of which also offered evidence of the surname of Mary's first husband. Cemetery records for Oak Grove Cemetery listed William Franz, d. Mar 1880, aged 38 yrs, and buried in the same section and lot that Mary would be buried in later.

1. "Mrs M Hafemann of Milwaukee, Wis." was listed as a surviving daughter of Mary Schueneman in Mary's obituary in 1928.
2. It is likely this daughter was born prior to Mary's marriage to Charles Scheunemann in 1882 because there is no daughter with a given name beginning "M" listed in the 1900 census record for Charles & Mary's household. Consequently, this daughter's maiden name is likely "Franz".
3. There is a marriage record for "Maria C Franz" on 4 Feb 1896 in La Crosse County (Wisconsin Historical Society Genealogy Database - online), but the same source did not have a record for the husband.
4. The 1900 Census lists a Herman Hafemann household in Milwaukee and wife Marie (age 22, b. Nov 1877 WI) and the record indicates they had been married for 4 years, thus married ca. 1896.

Taken together, RLN speculates that this daughter's name is Maria C Franz and eventually married Herman Hafemann.
