1. **David Pitman-1** ^[1]. He was born on 30 Dec 1774 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia ^[1]. He died on 11 Jul 1855 in Spencer Township, Harrison County, Indiana ^[2, 3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[4].

Mary Ann Aucherman is the daughter of Eliza <?> ^[2, 5]. She was born Apr 1782 ^[2]. She died on 14 Jun 1858 in Spencer Township, Harrison County, Indiana ^[2, 4]. She was also known as Mary Ann Ouchleman. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[6].

David Pitman and Mary Ann Aucherman. They were married on 21 Oct 1802 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia ^[2, 3]. They had 14 children.

Relationship Notes:

[1820 Harrison Co. Census]

Lists a David Pittman (sic) plus 2 males under 10 yrs old, 1 male 10-15 yrs old, 1 male 16-25 yrs old, 1 male 45 or older (David?), 4 females under 10 yrs old, 1 female 10-15 yrs old, 2 females 16-25 yrs old, and 1 female 26-44 yrs old (Mary?). David's age as 45 or older would equal a birthdate of 1775 or earlier, agreeing with his recorded birthdate.

[1830 Harrison Co. Census]

Lists a David Pitman plus 1 male under 5 yrs old, 1 male 10-14 yrs old, 1 male 15-19, 1 male 20-29, 1 male 50-60 (David?), 1 female under 5 yrs old, 1 female 5-9 yrs old, 2 females 10-14 yrs old, 1 female 15-19 yrs old, 1 female 20-29 yrs old, and 1 female 40-49 yrs old (Mary?).

[1840 Harrison Co. Census]

Lists a David Pitman (60-69 yrs old) plus 1 male 10-14 yrs old, 1 male 20-29 yrs old, 1 female 10-14 yrs old, 1 female 20-29 yrs old, and 1 female 50-59 yrs old (Mary?).

[1850 Harrison Co. Census]

Lists a David Pitman (76 yrs old and a farmer) in Distr. 45 and includes Mary (67 yrs), Joseph (33 yrs), wife Mariah (30 yrs), Isaac (9 yrs), Elisabeth (8 yrs), Minerva (5 yrs), Amanda (4 yrs), and Martin (1 yr). Joseph Cooper (17 yrs) is also listed with the family and identified as a laborer.

- i. **Judith Pitman** ^[7]. She was born on 11 Dec 1803 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia ^[7]. She married Joseph Wilson. They were married on 24 Nov 1826 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[8, 9]. She died on 04 Nov 1830 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[10].

Notes for Judith Pitman:

General Notes:

The 1830 census of Harrison Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana lists a Joseph Wilson household with two males under 40, 3 females under 5, and one female under 30. David Pitman's household is the second one following this entry, so RLN assumes that this one is the husband of Judith Pitman, dau. of David and Mary Ann.

- ii. **David Pitman Jr.** ^[7]. He was born 1805 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia ^[7]. He died on 23 Nov 1829 in Spencer Township, Harrison County, Indiana ^[7]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[11].
- iii. **Gideon Pitman** ^[7]. He was born on 02 Mar 1807 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia ^[12]. He died on 18 Aug 1828 in Spencer Township, Harrison County, Indiana ^[12]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[11, 13].

- iv. **Lydia Pitman** [7]. She was born on 11 Oct 1808 in Shenandoah Co., Virginia [12]. She married Samuel Senseney. They were married on 18 Mar 1827 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14, 15]. She died Bef. 30 Dec 1850 [16].
- v. **Elizabeth Pitman** [7]. She was born on 16 May 1810 in Shenandoah County, Virginia [12]. She married Peter Hottel. They were married on 26 Aug 1830 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14]. She died on 09 Sep 1844 [4]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [4].
- vi. **Catherine Pitman** [7]. She was born on 31 Dec 1811 in Shenandoah County, Virginia [7, 3]. She married Jacob Crabill. They were married on 29 Mar 1839 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14]. She died on 26 Sep 1871 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [4]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [11, 17].
- vii. **Isaac Edward Pitman** [7]. He was born on 04 Sep 1814 in Shenandoah County, Virginia [12, 18]. He married Mary Ann Kintner. They were married on 19 Mar 1839 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [19]. Will on 11 Mar 1864 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [20]. He died on 24 May 1866 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [18]. Burial in Applegate-Pittman Cemetery, Heth Twp, Harrison Co, IN [21].
- viii. **Joseph Pitman** [7, 22]. He was born on 14 Jun 1816 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. He married Mariah Mason. They were married on 17 Oct 1839 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14]. He died on 16 Oct 1872 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [7, 3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [4, 11].
- ix. **Flora Pitman** [23, 24]. She was born on 07 Mar 1817 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [25, 26]. She married Joseph Pitman. They were married on 10 Oct 1839 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [27, 28]. She died on 11 Jun 1850 in Knox County, Illinois [29, 30]. Burial in Rice-Blue Cemetery, Henderson Twp, Knox County, Illinois [31].
- x. **Susan Pitman** [7]. She was born on 10 Sep 1818 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [7, 3]. She married Philip Rosenbarger. They were married on 23 Apr 1841 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14]. She died on 01 Aug 1897 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [4, 11].
- xi. **Mary Pitman** [7]. She was born on 11 Mar 1821 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. She married Levi Hottel. They were married on 24 Oct 1841 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [32]. She died on 21 Apr 1851 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [33].
- xii. **Philip Pitman** [7, 34]. He was born on 09 Dec 1821 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [7, 3]. He died on 11 Aug 1822 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [7, 3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [11, 13].
- xiii. **Levi Pitman** [7]. He was born Jul 1825 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. He died on 19 Oct 1847 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [3]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [4, 11].

Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [36, 4].
