1. **Mary Pitman-1** ^[1]. She was born on 11 Mar 1821 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[2]. She died on 21 Apr 1851 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[2]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[3].

Levi Hottel is the son of John Conrad Hottel and Barbara Funkhouser ^[1, 4, 5]. He was born on 09 Oct 1817 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[6, 7]. Will on 07 Nov 1891 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA. He died on 06 Jun 1896 ^[8]. Burial in Hottel (Conrad) Cemetery, Feller Rd, Harrison County, Indiana ^[9].

Levi Hottel and Mary Pitman. They were married on 24 Oct 1841 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA ^[10]. They had 2 children.

Relationship Notes:

Levi Hottel married Christiana Snider, daughter of John and Catherine (Pittman) Snider, following the death of his first wife Mary Pitman, daughter of David and Mary Ann (Aucherman) Pitman. Mary and Christiana were 2nd cousins. Levi and Christiana owned the old John Pittman Sr property near White Cloud in Scott Township, Harrison County, Indiana that includes the Hottel/Conrad Cemetery. Levi and Christiana bore six children: Jacob (1855), Caroline Margaret (1855), John H (1858), Mary (1860), Peter A (1863), and Levi S (age 1869).

- i. **Rebecca Hottel** ^[11, 12]. She was born on 06 Oct 1843 ^[13, 14]. She died on 10 Oct 1855 ^[13]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana ^[11].

 - ii. **Julia A. Hottel** ^[15, 16, 17, 18]. She was born Bet. 1848–1850 in Indiana, USA ^[15, 18, 19]. She died Aft. Nov 1891 ^[20]. She married Jacob Hausewald.

2. **Julia A. Hottel-2** (Mary Pitman-1) ^[15, 16, 17, 18]. She was born Bet. 1848–1850 in Indiana, USA ^[15, 18, 19]. She died Aft. Nov 1891 ^[20].

Jacob Hausewald is the son of Barbara ____ ^[21, 22]. He was born Bet. 1845–1847 in France ^[19, 22]. He was also known as Jacob Housewalt ^[19].
