"Mrs Susan Rosenbarger died at her home in Spencer township last Sunday evening in the 79th year of her age. The deceased was born in Virginia September 10, 1818 and came to this county when quite young, where she has resided ever since. She was united in marriage with Philip Rosenbarger April 22, 1841, whose death she has survived twelve years. She had for many years been a faithful member of the German Reform church. Though her late suffering was intense she bore it with christian fortitude. She leaves two sons, three daughters and a wide circle of friends to mourn her death. The funeral took place Monday afternoon and was conducted by Rev. N.S. Peter."

Philip Rosenbarger is the son of Rudolph Rosenberger and Barbara Hamman [1, 2]. He was born on 28 Apr 1815 in Virginia, USA [4]. He died on 09 Oct 1887 [4]. Burial in Pitman Cemetery, Moberley Rd., Harrison Co., Indiana [4].

Lists Philip Rosenbarger (sic) (65 yrs, farmer, b. Virginia) plus wife Susan (63 yrs, b. Virginia), son Willard (24 yrs, farmer, b. Indiana) and daughter Emina J. (18 yrs, b. Indiana). Also listed in the household is George W. Tipton (16 yrs, laborer).
