Cause Of Death was Pneumonia. Occupation was Farmer [12]. Political Views was Democrat [13]. Communicant was Cumberland Presbyterian Church [13]. Burial in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Nehawka, Cass, Nebraska, USA [14, 6].

General Notes:

A curious entry in the Harrison County court records indicates "Mary, Andrew and Wesley Pitman, infant heirs to John Eddleman, deceased, David Pitman named guardian." (Keasling, Lynne C.M. Jan 2008. Harrison County Indiana Guardianships, July 1817 to Feb 1853. GC 977.201 H24KE). My records indicate that John Eddleman was the grandfather of David's children and father of his first wife Catherine who died abt 1834.

Catherine Eddleman is the daughter of John Eddleman and Mary Zumwalt [7]. She was born Abt. 1800 in Kentucky, USA [12, 15]. She died Abt. 1834 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [16, 17, 18]. Burial in yet unknown cemetery.

David Pittman and Catherine Eddleman. They were married on 06 Aug 1827 in Floyd County, Indiana, USA [16]. They had 4 children.

Relationship Notes:

The 1830 U.S. Harrison Co., Heth Twp Census lists David Pitman (sic) household: 1 male under 5 yrs old (James), 1 male 20-29 yrs old (David), 1 female under 5 yrs old (Mary C), and 1 female 20-29 yrs old (Catherine).

The 1840 U.S. Harrison Co., Harrison Twp Census lists David Pitman (sic) household: 2 males 5-9 yrs old (Andrew & John W), 1 male 10-14 yrs old (James), 1 male 30-39 yrs old (David), 1 female under 5 yrs old (Amelia E), 1 female 5-9 yrs old (Mary C), and 1 female 30-39 yrs old (Catherine).

He died on 22 Mar 1880 in Corydon, Harrison, Indiana, USA [21, 7]. Burial in Jordan Cemetery, Harrison Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana [21, 23].
- ii. **Mary Catherine Pittman** [24, 25, 20]. She was born 1830 in Indiana, USA [24, 26]. She died on 11 Feb 1855 in Corydon, Harrison, Indiana, USA [27]. Burial in Jordan Cemetery, Harrison Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana [21, 23].

- iv. **John Wesley Pittman** [34, 35, 20]. He was born on 25 Mar 1834 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [34, 36, 37]. Fact 1855 (Moved to Weston, Marion County, Iowa.) [34]. He married Lydia A. Goodwin. They were married on 29 Jan 1857 in Marion Co, Iowa. Fact 2 1859 (Preempted land in Rock Bluff Precinct, Cass County, Nebr.) [34]. He died on 17 Jan 1919 in Nebraska, USA [37]. Education in University, a United Brethren Church college in Hartsville, IN and direct predecessor to Huntington University. (Hartsville Academy) [38]. Occupation was Taught school and sold dry-goods in Weston, Marion County, Iowa for several years after finishing studies at the university in Hartsville. [36]. Residence was Resided on 160ac farm in Sec 15, Liberty Pct, Cass Co, Nebraska. [36]. Burial in East Union Cemetery, north of Union, Cass, Nebraska [39].

Mary E. Young is the daughter of Jacob Young [13, 40]. She was born on 24 Mar 1807 in North Carolina, USA [10, 41, 40, 42]. She died on 25 Dec 1881 in Union, Nebraska [10, 43, 42]. Cause Of Death was Dropsy. Religion in United Brethren Church [13]. Burial in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Nehawka, Cass, Nebraska, USA [14, 42].

David Pittman and Mary E. Young. They were married on 12 May 1837 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [44, 45]. They had 2 children.

Relationship Notes:

In 1873, they moved from Harrison Co., Ind. to Cass Co., Neb., residing with their son Eli near Union until their death.
