Fact 2 1856 (Resided w/ family on a farm in Pleasant Grove Twp, Marion Co, Iowa) [5]. Fact 3 1860 (Resided on a farm w/ family in Pleasant Grove Twp, Marion Co, Iowa) [6]. Fact 4 1870 (Resided on farm in Wea Twp, Miami Co, KS) [7]. Fact 5 Jun 1880 (Resided w/ daughter Elizabeth and family on a farm in Wea Twp, Miami Co, KS.) [8]. He died Aft. Jun 1880 in Miami Co., Kansas [9, 8]. Burial in Glenwild Cemetery, West Line, Cass Co, MO [10, 9].

Mary Elizabeth Grant is the daughter of George Grant and Mary Berry [3, 11, 12]. She was born 1807 in Bourbon Co., Kentucky [13, 12]. She died 1873 in Miami Co., Kansas [12]. Burial in Glenwild Cemetery, West Line, Cass Co, MO [12].

Isaac Noah Pitman and Mary Elizabeth Grant. They were married on 10 Nov 1825 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14, 15]. They had 9 children.

- i. **Elizabeth Pitman** [16, 17, 18, 4]. She was born on 17 Oct 1826 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [19]. She married Robert Morrow. They were married Abt. 1851 in El Dorado County, California, USA [16]. She died on 17 Jul 1907 in Conway, McPherson Co., Kansas [20]. Burial in Monitor Church of the Brethren Cemetery, Monitor, McPherson, Kansas, USA [21].
- ii. **John Berry Pitman** [19, 4]. He was born Bet. 1828–1829 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [19, 4]. He died 1852 [22]. Cause Of Death was cholera. Medical Condition was died returning from goldfields of California [13]. Burial in New Orleans, Louisiana [23].
- iii. **George Fletcher Pitman** [19, 5, 4]. He was born on 05 Apr 1830 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [19]. He married Mary Ann Polson. They were married on 17 Dec 1856 in Marion Co, Iowa [19]. He died on 24 Oct 1895 in Pleasantville, Marion, Iowa, USA [19]. Burial in Pleasant Grove Cemetery, Marion Co, Pleasantville, Iowa [13, 24].
- iv. **Philip Wesley Pitman** [5, 25, 4]. He was born on 17 Nov 1833 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [26, 27, 28]. He married Caroline Newman. They were married on 22 Apr 1857 in Marion Co, Iowa [29, 26]. He died on 08 Aug 1914 in Louisburg, Miami, Kansas, USA [26, 28]. He was also known as Wesley Pittman [27]. Burial in Louisburg Cemetery, Louisburg, Miami Co, Kansas [28].
- v. **Mahala Pitman** [4]. She was born Abt. 1834 in Indiana, USA [4].
- vi. **William Franklin Pitman** [30, 5, 4]. He was born on 28 May 1837 in Knox County, Illinois [31]. He married Rebecca Winterhalter. They were married on 10 Jan 1861 in Marion Co, Iowa [31]. He died on 20 Aug 1893 in Warren County, Iowa [32]. Burial in Belmont Zion Baptist Cemetery, Milo, Iowa [32, 33].
- vii. **Thomas G. Pitman** [34, 35]. He was born on 29 Jul 1839 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [34]. He died on 01 Sep 1853 in Pleasantville, Marion, Iowa, USA [36, 37]. Burial in Pleasant Grove Cemetery, Marion Co, Pleasantville, Iowa [38].
- viii. **Abigail Pitman** [4]. She was born Abt. 1841 in Indiana, USA [39].

- ix. **Robert D. (Doc) Pitman** [34, 5, 4, 6]. He was born 1842 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [34, 40, 4]. He married Sidney Newman. They were married on 10 Sep 1866 in Marion Co, Iowa [34]. He died 1918 in Miami Co., Kansas [34, 40]. Burial in Louisburg Cemetery, Louisburg, Miami Co, Kansas [40].
