DIED. At the residence of her son, Hon. John W. Lopp, near Mauckport, Indiana, on Saturday evening, the 24th ultimo, Mrs. Mary M. Lopp, sister of David Pitman, Esqr., of this county. Mrs. Lopp was very suddenly taken off, probably by an apoplectic fit, or some disease of the heart, having been enjoying the best of health until fifteen minutes before her death, when she was seized with a smothering sensation, and died almost immediately. The deceased was one of the early pioneers of Indiana, having emigrated with her father, John Pitman, from the Shenandoah Valley, Virginia, in the year 1808, and settled in what is now Scott Township, in this county. She became a member of the Lutheran Church more than thirty years ago. And has ever since lived the life of an earnest, sincere, Christian, striving to follow the example of the meek and lowly Jesus. In the death of mother Lopp, the church has lost one of its brighter ornaments, society one of its best and most useful members, and her family a devoted mother and sister. She leaves a large circle of relations and friends to mourn her loss. Thus one by one the old pioneers-mothers in Israel-are gathered to the house of their Father.

John Lopp is the son of Jacob Lopp Jr. and Mary Margaret Boss [1]. He was born on 06 Nov 1794 in Rowan County, North Carolina [11]. He died on 27 Oct 1846 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [12, 6, 7]. Burial in Beechwood Cemetery, Heth Twp, Harrison Co, IN [7, 13, 9, 14].

Discrepancies regarding marriage of Lucretia:

The 1880 census lists an Asa A Armen (age 27, SINGLE, music teacher) as a boarder in Daniel Clark's household in Hillsdale County, Michigan.

Wolph (1980) said that Lucretia married Asa Armen in 1 July 1884. A footnote for Asa indicates he was married a second time and changed his name to Condo.

The Indiana Marriage Collection, 1800 - 1941 indicates Asa A Armen and Lucretia Shuck were married 1 Jul 1884 in Bartholomew County, Indiana.

The 1890-91 Kearney Nebraska Directory lists a Rev. Asa A. Armen, pastor, United Brethren Church.

The 1900 census lists Lucretia Armen in Mary Shuck's household on 812 Hutchins Ave in Columbus, Indiana and indicates she was a WIDOW.

The 1900 census lists an Adam B Condo in Cooke Co, TX with the same birth date (Nov 1854) as that on Condo's gravestone in Hartsville Cem and indicates he was SINGLE and a music teacher.

The 1920 census lists Adam B & Lucretia S Condo at 809 Hutchins Ave in Columbus, Indiana.

The 1930 census lists Adam B and Lucretia Condo at 809 Hutchins Ave in

Columbus, Indiana and lists their respective ages "at 1st marriage" as 29 and 22. That would roughly equal a marriage date of 1884.

In her 1923 passport application, there is testimony that she and Adam B Condo were married on 1 May 1884 and that he was born on 16 Nov 1854. Her parents were similarly identified as Jeremiah and Mary Shuck.

So.....it is possible that Asa and Lucretia divorced prior to 1900, then she described herself as widowed in the 1900 census to avoid the embarrassment of being divorced, then Asa changed his name to Adam B Condo, and then they remarried prior to 1920?
