"Miss Mahala Loudon, daughter of William S. and Mary A. Loudon, died last Saturday morning. The deceased was a most estimable young lady, beloved by all who knew her. She was ill for some time, and before her death lost the senses of hearing, speech, and sight, but she bore her afflictions with genuine christian fortitude. Though deprived of communicating with her friends by speech before her death, she imparted such statements as she desired to them by writing them. The last sentence written by her was "Praise the Lord." From this noble sentiment her funeral discourse was preached by Rev. N. V. Moore, last Sabbath, to a large assembly of sorrowing friends."
