1. **Sarah Pittman-1** [1, 2]. She was born Bet. 1792–1794 in Near Strasburg, Shenandoah County, Virginia [1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6]. Fact 1850 (Resided w/ husband and children Philip, Elizabeth on a farm in District 45, Harrison Co, IN) [5]. Fact 2 1860 (Resided w/ Jonas and son John plus his wife and child on a farm in Washington Twp, Harrison Co, IN) [6]. Fact 3 1870 (Along w/ husband Jonas, resided with son John and family on a farm in Washington twp, Harrison Co, IN) [3]. She died Aft. 02 Jul 1870 [7, 3, 8]. She was also known as Sallie Pittman [3]. Burial in Fleshman Family Cemetery, Washington Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana [9].

Jonas Fleischmann is the son of Ephraim Fleischmann and Susannah Yeager [10, 5, 6]. He was born on 24 Sep 1785 in Madison, Virginia, USA [11]. He died 1877 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [12, 8]. He was also known as Jonas Fleshman. Burial in Fleshman Family Cemetery, Washington Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana [13].

Jonas Fleischmann and Sarah Pittman. They were married on 01 Nov 1810 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [14]. They had 6 children.

- i. **Catherine Fleshman** [15, 16]. She was born on 01 Nov 1810 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [17]. She married David Hardsaw. They were married on 29 May 1832 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [18, 19]. Will on 25 Jul 1889 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [20]. She died on 14 Jul 1892 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [17]. Burial in Wesley Chapel Cemetery, Washington Twp, Harrison County, Indiana [17, 21].
- ii. **John Philip Fleshman** [3, 22, 5, 6]. He was born on 01 Apr 1813 in Indiana, USA [22, 23]. He married Elizabeth Hisey. They were married on 18 Jun 1859 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [24]. He died on 27 May 1881 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [25, 23]. Will on 21 Jan 1884 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [26]. Burial in Fleshman Family Cemetery, Washington Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana.
- iii. **Mary A. Fleshman** [27]. She was born on 23 Feb 1814 [17]. She married John Trotter. They were married on 05 Feb 1836 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [28]. She died on 26 Mar 1880 [29]. Burial in Wesley Chapel Cemetery, Washington Twp, Harrison County, Indiana [17, 30].
- iv. **Lydia Fleshman** [31]. She was born on 01 Feb 1820 [31]. She married James A. Trotter. They were married on 03 Mar 1838 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [18, 32]. She died on 11 Apr 1899 [31]. Burial in Flora Cemetery, Mauckport, Harrison Co, Indiana [31, 33].
- v. **Rhoda Jane Fleshman** [34]. She was born Bet. 1825–1833 in Indiana, USA [34, 35, 36, 37]. She married Hugh French. They were married on 15 Feb 1849 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [34, 38, 18]. Fact 1850 (Resided w/ husband Hugh in Harrison Co, Indiana.) [35]. Fact 2 Bet. 1860–1880 (Resided w/ family in Washington Twp, Harrison Co, Indiana.) [36, 39, 37].
- vi. **Elizabeth Fleshman** [40]. She was born on 14 May 1828 [41, 42, 43, 44]. She married Andrew Jackson Walk. They were married on 18 Dec 1849 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [18]. She died on 15 Dec 1880 in Harrison County, Indiana, USA [41, 43]. Burial in Bethlehem Cemetery, Jackson Twp, Harrison Co, IN [34, 43].

Haunted Hallow is located between Mauckport and Wesley Chapel on River Road.

Lore [Love?] for legacy to his late wife Adda L. dated 12 May 1899, and c) payment of \$250 to Fannie and Jacob C Frank for legacy dated 8 Apr 1899.
