OBITUARY
Lydia GOODWIN was born March 15, 1840, at Lafayette, Ind., and departed this life Dec. 16, 1918, aged 78 years, 9 months and 1 day.
She was married to Wesley PITTMAN at Pleasantville, Iowa, Jan. 29, 1857. Nine children were born to this union, 6 of whom are still living, and are present today except one. Miss Josephine PITTMAN, whose home is at Weeping Water; Hattie J. SHRYDER, Portland, Oregon; Chas. of Ft. Morgan, Colo.; James of Union; Edward, residence unknown; and Mrs. Birdie GALLOWAY, who is living at home caring for her parents in their infirmities [sic].
She was a pioneer of Nebraska having crossed the Missouri river on May 28, 1859, at Plattsmouth. They settled at Mt. Pleasant, where they lived until the following March, when they moved to Nebraska City, where they resided for 9 years, then moved onto the farm where they have lived for over fifty years. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church at Union and was always loyal, but on account of her affliction she was not a regular attendant. She was a good wife, a loving mother and had a happy disposition, which made her beloved by all who knew her, and she will be sadly missed in the home and community where she has lived so long. She leaves beside her immediate family, two brothers, eleven grandchildren and 3 great grand children to mourn her loss.
