"Death of James H Trotter. James H. Trotter died at his home at New Amsterdam, last Sunday afternoon. The deceased had been boating lime between New Amsterdam and Evansville, and while his boat was lying at Evansville, about two weeks prior to his death, he became ill of dysentery. He came home, and continued to grow worse for some ten days after his arrival when he died. The deceased was an honest, upright citizen. He was the assessor of his township, and respected by all who knew him. He was a member of the New Amsterdam Lodge of Knights of Honor, under the auspices of which lodge he was buried last Monday. The funeral discourse was preached by Rev. Troy, of the Mauckport M.E. circuit, at Wesley Chapel in Washington township. His funeral was one of the largest in the township for years."

Roscoe Trotter died at the home of his mother in Washington township, last Friday, aged 21 years and 7 months. The funeral was held from Wesley Chapel church Sunday morning and the remains were laid to rest in the presence of a very large concourse of people. The funeral was conducted under the auspices of the Modern Woodmen order, of which deceased was a member. Dr. A.M. Irvine, of Corydon, preached a touching funeral sermon. The music was furnished by an organist and choir from this place. Miss Winnie Brewster presided at the organ and the quartet composed of Mrs G.W. Applegate, Sr., Miss Annie Stevens, John H. Heth, and W.J. Bulleit, sang several appropriate selections. Deceased died of typhoid fever and had been sick about a week. It is believed that he contracted the disease while at Painsville, Ky., about a month ago. He was a member of a ball team which played at that place and drank water from a well containing the typhoid germs as the boys were apprised after it was too late. It seemed to be a malignant type of fever, from the inception and brain trouble developing he soon succumbed to the ravages of this disease. He was at Valparaiso during the Spring and Summer attending school. After returning home from school a little over a month ago, he entered into the store business at Valley City with his brother, Ray, and helped to conduct the store and postoffice until his illness. He was a popular young man and had many friends. He is survived by his mother Helen Trotter, two brothers Harry and Ray, and two sisters, Miss Cortez Miller, and Miss Jennie Trotter, all of this county.
