

Magdalene Snyder's last will

I Magdalene Snyder of the County of Grant in the State of Indiana do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say: First it is my will that my funeral expenses and all my just debts be fully paid. I do give unto my son George or his heirs Daniel, Henry, Jacob, David & Samuel Snyder or their heirs and to my daughter Christiana Sumner one dollar each or to their heirs. I do give devise and bequeath to my son Joseph Snyder all the residue of my estate or dower which is or may be coming to me in Pennsylvania and Ohio or other debts due or demands or property personal or real. And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my son Joseph Snyder to be the executor for this my last will and testament. Revoking and annulling said annulling all former wills by me made and ratified and accompanying this and no other to be my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of January A.D. 1848. Signed published and declared by the above named Magdalene Snyder as and for her last will and testament in presence of us who at her request have signed as witnesses to the same,

 1850 I personally appeared in the Clerk's
 office of the Grant Probate Court Thomas Dean a man of lawful
 age being one of the subscribing witnesses to the last will and testa-
 ment of Magdalene Snyder late of said County deceased who being
 duly sworn upon his solemn oath said that he Thomas Dean a
 Noah Reasner were the subscribing witnesses to the last will and
 Testament of Magdalene Snyder late of Grant County deceased
 as made and published by her on the 25th day of January
 A.D. 1850 and that said will was duly witnessed by us in the
 presence of the said Magdalene Snyder and in the presence of each other
 and that he (Dean) truly believes that said will was duly ex-
 ecuted by the said Magdalene at the time of making the same and
 the said Magdalene requested the said Dean and the said Noah
 Reasner to sign their names to the said will in her presence
 and that said testator was at the time of making and execu-
 tion of said will of lawful age to dispose her property and of
 sound mind and memory and that said testator acknow-
 ledged said will and required the same to be signed without
 coercion or restraint.
