Be it remembered that on the tenth day of October 1857 Thomas L Poore filed with me his affidavit charging said defendant with having on or about the tenth day of October 1857 committed an assault and battery with intent to murder upon the body of one Thomas Williams with intent to murder him the said Williams.

October 10th 1857 a warrant issued for the defendant, and a subpoena for the following witnesses to wit Daniel Coker Thomas L Poore Dr. Ferry & Thomas Williams; given to Basil Clements Const.

And now on the 26th day of October 1857 said Constable brought the defendant into Court and made return of said warrant and subpoena served as commanded; whereupon the defendant, ^{without trial} entered into recognizance for his appearance at the first ~~day~~ term of the Court of Common Pleas of Delaware County, with William A Long and Amos Wilson as sureties
