DIRECTIONS FOR SETTING
FOR BATTERY OPERATED QUARTZ MOVEMENT
ALSO SERIES QUARTZ MOVEMENT

1. Wind springs fully. This should be done weekly.
2. To set -- If clock does not start immediately after winding move crown back one or three rotations forward and backward.
3. To set minute track -- Crown with left hand, set the crown. Push crown right one click. Push crown right one click.
4. To set hour track -- Push crown right one click.
5. Set date by moving hand to other direction. It is not necessary to push the crown to either the front or back. Push crown right one click and date will automatically reposition the number of dates.
6. To regulate -- Stop balance wheel. Turn the minute track the proper amount backward or forward. It is not necessary to push the crown to either the front or back. Push crown right one click and date will automatically reposition the number of dates.
7. To adjust -- Turn back on back of case to adjust.
