The Louisiana State Capitol is the tallest building in the South, 34 floors, height to top of beacon light 450 feet. The Huey P. Long Bridge is 4.4 miles long including approaches, the finest span across the Mississippi, central pier, 409 feet high equal to a 36 story office building; 135 feet vertical clearance for steamers; 720 feet horizontal clearance; cost \$13,000,000.

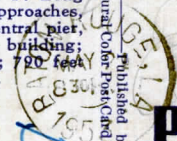

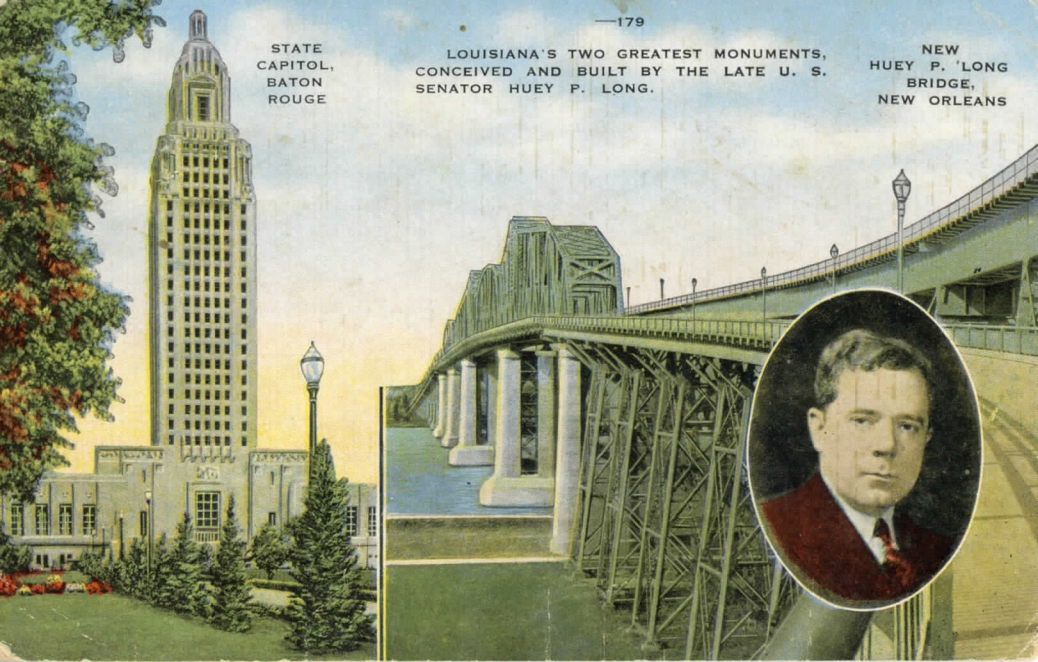
