on sick furlough dated Jan 20. Expires Feb 12, 1862."  
March & April /62 present: and same to Oct 31 /62.  
Nov & Dec /62 absent on detached service since Dec 5 /62;  
and same to Feb 28 /63. March & April /63 present: and  
same to Dec 31 /63. Re-enlisted as a Vet Vol Jan 30  
1864. Designation changed to Co. C 8<sup>th</sup> Ohio Cav.  
Roll from Jan 30<sup>th</sup> to April 30 /64 absent without leave  
since April 29 /64. May & June /64 present with pr-  
mark: "Stop one month and 5 days pay for absence without  
leave as per sentence of Court Martial." July & Aug /64
