




Magdalena Snyder's Last Will

I Magdalena Snyder of the County of Grant in the State of Indiana do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is today. First it is my will that my funeral expenses and all my just debts be fully paid. Second I give unto my sons George or his heirs Daniel, Henry, Jacob, David & Samuel Snyder or their heirs and to my daughter Christian Sumforte one dollar each or to their heirs. Third I give devise and bequeath to my son Joseph Snyder all the residue of my Estate or dower which is or may be coming to me in Pennsylvania and Ohio or other debts dues or demands or property personal or real. And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my son Joseph Snyder to be the executor for this my last will and testament revoking and (crossed out) annulling all former wills by me made and certified and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of January AD 1848. Signed published and declared by the above named Magdalena Snyder in and for her last will and testament in presence of me to be at her request have signed as witnesses to the same,

Grant County, Be it Remembered that on this 27th day of February AD 1850 personally appeared in the clerks office of the Grant Probate Court. Thomas Dean a man of lawful age being one of the subscribing witnesses to the last will and testament of Magdalena Snyder late of said county deceased who being

duly sworn upon his solemn oath saith that he Thomas Dean and Noah Reasoner were the subscribing witnesses to the last will and testament of Magdalena Snyder late of Grant County deceased as made and published by her on the 25th day of January AD 1848 and that said will was duly witnessed by us in the presence of the said Magdalena Snyder and in the presence of each other and that he Dean truly believes that said will was duly executed by the said Magdalena at the time of making the same and the said Magdalena requested the said Dean and the said Noah Reasoner to sign their names to the said will in her presence and that said testator was at the time of making and executing said will of lawful age to devise her property and of sound mind and memory and that said testator acknowledges said will and required the same to be signed without co-_____ or restraint.

DEATH CLAIMS WIDOW WORTHEN

Aged and Well Known Woman called to Reward

Came to Hartford City Nearly Three-quarters of a Century Ago - Funeral Thursday

Mrs. Elizabeth Worthen, 86, died at her home on east Water street, Tuesday morning at 4 o'clock. She had been ill for six weeks with the grip. Other complications set in and her condition was critical a week before the end.

The surviving children are William and John Worthen, Mrs. J. D. White and Mrs. Charles Reed, of this city, and Marvel Worthen, of Chicago.

Mrs. Worthen was born August 13, eighty-five years ago, in Stark County, O. She came to Hartford City with her parents when a girl of thirteen and continued to reside here until her death. Her maiden name was Snyder. Besides the five children and sister Mrs. Mary Swift of this city and a brother, Jerry Snyder, of Nebraska, survive. Her husband, J P Worthen, died about six years ago.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the house 209 East Water street, and interment will be made in the I.O.O.F cemetery.

Next Tues it is supposed to rain, hope it doesn't ruin the fruit, the trees are just blossoming out. I saw your storm on the news, it looked like a really good one. The picture I was talking about emailing you, I have decided to mail it, it will lose too much via email.

I cannot imagine where I got the marriage dates I sent you, it is not in my Snyder file, although as I told you, my files are in a real mess. I even found Worthen and Haas info in the Snyder file. At this point I have no info on either Rebecca or Hester Snyder. However, the John Snyder [ID1471] who married Nancy Smith [ID1472] is the son of Joseph Snider. (Joseph's mother spelled her name Snyder, but the Hoosier Genealogist and the Grant Co. marriages compiled by John Kendall both spell it Snider). Mary Snider [ID1903] who married Richard Swift [ID1470] is the sister of your GR.Gr. Gr. mother Elizabeth [ID0407]. John is their brother. Rebecca and Hester could be cousins to John and Mary or children of Joseph's other brothers. Seems like they were all in Grant County

We do not have much on the Snyders either. It is such a common name it is almost impossible to trace back further than Joseph's parents and their 7 children. [I only show 3 children - Elizabeth, Mary, John (from Email)]

At this point I have no info on either Rebecca or Hester Snyder. However, the John Snyder [ID1471] who married Nancy Smith [ID1472] is the son of Joseph Snider. (Joseph's mother spelled her name Snyder, but the Hoosier Genealogist and the Grant Co. marriages compiled by John Kendall both spell it Snider). Mary Snider [ID1903] who married Richard Swift [ID1470] is the sister of your GR.Gr. Gr. mother Elizabeth [ID0407]. John is their brother. Rebecca and Hester could be cousins to John and Mary or children of Joseph's other brothers. Seems like they were all in Grant County

We do not have much on the Snyders either. It is such a common name it is almost impossible to trace back further than Joseph's parents and their 7 children. [I only show 3 children - Elizabeth, Mary, John (from Email)]

One of the Older Residents Dies of Neuralgia of the Heart

J. P. Worthen died rather unexpectedly at his home on east Water street at 5 o'clock Saturday morning at the age of 84, and one of the oldest and best esteemed citizens is called home. Mr. Worthen had been failing for several months and for a few days before his death he was complaining of neuralgia of the stomach, but he was believed to be better Friday evening. It seems that his death was due to neuralgia of the heart which came suddenly.

Perry Worthen had been a resident of this city for sixty years, but he was a native of Maryland, having been born in Fredericksburg, Perry county, that state. He was married in this city November 2, 1848, and his aged wife survives him. He was the father of nine children of whom five are living - Mrs. Mary E White, John, William and Marvel Worthen and Mrs. Emma Reed. The children all live in this city with the exception of Marvel, whose home is in Chicago.

Mr. Worthen was a sincere and earnest church worker and a kindly man who had no enemies and counted as friends all his acquaintances. For [two lines obscured by a crease] knew him so well, but the older residents will feel a pang of sorrow when they learn he has passed away.

Mr. Worthen will be buried from his house Monday afternoon. Interment taking place in the Oddfellows cemetery.
