6. Obituary, The Noblesville Ledger of Friday 12 June 1925. Extract:

"The remains of Miss Lula Baker age 54 years-11 month, who died at the Grand Hospital in Chicago, were Brought to Sheridan, Thursday. The body was taken to the J.HJ. Campbell home at Bakers Corner, where funeral services were held Friday with burial at the Bakers Corner cemetery. Rev. F.V. Stafford officiated at the service.

The deceased is survived by only one immediate relative, a sister living in Arkansas. The parents and one sister are interned at the Bakers Corner cemetery, and one brother in Marshaltown, lowa.

Miss Baker was the daughter of the late Enos Baker, who with his family moved from the Bakers Corner community several years ago to Iowa, from whence they went to Chicago, Illinois."
