Walt –

So sorry! I'm trying to finish up your questions this evening!

1. Thomas D. Baker – my research indicates his parents were likely Joseph and Rachel (Dilworth) Baker.
2. Thomas D. Baker – b. c. 9/1838, d. aft. 1920 in possibly Hamilton County, IN. Unsure.
3. John Yarnall/Yarnell Baker – b. 10/1812, d. 12/9/1895 in Hamilton County, IN, buried in Baker's Corner Cemetery.
4. Rachel H. Anthony – b. 5/1813 in Clinton Cnty., OH, d. 4/6/1890 in Hamilton County, IN, buried in Baker's Corner Cemetery.
5. Joseph R. Baker (father of Thomas D. Baker) – b. c. 1792, possibly Chester, PA, d. 4/1870 in Hamilton County, IN, buried in Baker's Corner.
6. Rachel Dilworth (mother of Thomas D. Baker) – b. c. 1800, PA, d. 9/1873, buried in Baker's Corner.
7. John Yarnall/Yarnell Baker & Rachel H. Anthony's marriage date – 11/30/1833 in Clinton County, OH.
8. Joseph R. Baker & Rachel Dilworth's marriage date – possibly 11/28/1822.
9. My Great Grandparents were Albert Kellam and Honora (Baker) Kellam. Honora was born 1/23/1877 in Hamilton County, IN. She married Albert Kellam in Madison County, Tennessee on 3/19/1892 (her parents, Anthony & Mary Eleanor Baker, moved to Tennessee to run a saw mill. Albert supposedly "came after" Honora, married her, and brought her back to Hamilton County, Indiana).
10. My Grandparents were Velma H. Kellam and Pliny Roberts. Velma was born to Honora and Anthony Baker on 3/8/1901 in Hamilton County, IN. Grandma Velma died 5/3/1973, and Grandpa Pliny died 10/29/1973. They both lived in Hortonville in Hamilton County, IN.
11. My Father is [ID3492]. My mother is [ID3493]. Dad was born at home in Hortonville in 1932. He lived his life in Hortonville until we moved in about 1972.

I think I've gotten most of your questions, but if I forgot something or there is something else I can add to help, let me know. And, I tell everyone, my files are definitely still "works in progress", so please do your own double checking. I'm sure there are still mistakes and/or updates I need to make!

Did you by any chance know who Honora Baker Kellam or Velma Kellam Roberts were (Great Grandmother and Grandmother)? Do you live or did you grow up in Hamilton County, IN? I lived the first 6 years of my life in Hortonville...just a few houses down from Grandparents. Then, we moved to Hendricks County. Today I live in Zionsville, Boone County, so not very far away still! I have two young daughters who are 9 and 10, if I didn't mention before. They're names are Jessica and Paige.
