## HARTFORD CITY MAN ENDS LIFE

Charles Jacobs Found Dead in Hotel After Drinking Carbolic Acid.

Hartford City, Ind., Oct. 2.— Charles Jacobs, 57, was found dead in his room at the White Hotel, this morning. He had ended his life by drinking carbolic acid. Coroner R. W. Burkhart, who investigated the case, stated that such would be his finding.

According to those who knew Jacobs well, he had been a heavy drinker for years, and since the advent of prohibition had drank liquors which were not intended for use as beverages. It is believed that loss of health and money caused him to become despondent.

He formerly had been a glass worker, but in recent times had been employed doing odd jobs about

the hotel.
