Henry Anderson Jr comes of age in the 1820's and it is hard to know if he is mixed with the entries for Henry Sr.

In 1831 the entry reads "Henry Anderson 0" suggesting that Henry has died that year. In 1830 Henry sold his Lot 32 to son William so this might be correct.

Mrs. H. A. Orr, whose death occurred at the home of her son, J. H. Orr, near Dundas, Tuesday morning, May 23d, was one of Minnesota's early settlers. Mrs. Orr's maiden name was Harriet Ann Anderson. She was born on the Anderson homestead which lie on the banks of the St. Lawrence river, in Ontario, Sept. 18, 1817. Her early girlhood was spent at the farm home and at the age of nineteen she was married to William Orr, removing to New York state, where they lived a short time, but finally returned to Ontario. In 1860 her husband died leaving her with ten children. Mrs. Orr continued her residence in Ontario until 1868* when with three of her children she came to Minnesota settling in the vicinity of Dundas, which to the time of her death had been her home. Her health was unusually good, and only Thursday of last week she complained of a slight sickness but said there was no need of medical attendance and on Monday seemed to have regained her usual health, with the exception of a slight difficulty in breathing. After eating quite a hearty supper she retired at her usual hour saying to her son and his wife that she was feeling considerably better and would b all right in a day o two. In the morning Mrs. J. H. Orr went to call her mother and found that she had expired in the night. The peaceful expression of her features and the undisturbed appearance of everything about her indicated that the end had come quietly and without a struggle. Of the ten children born to her nine are living, John and Leslie Orr and Mrs. Cleland, of Dundas, Harry Orr of Todd county, Geo. and Robert Orr and Mrs. Ferguson, of Michigan, Mrs. N. Davenport of Dundas, Mrs. J. Byar of Ontario, Can. The funeral was held at the Episcopal church in Dundas Thursday afternoon at 2:30, Rev. E. Moyses conducting the service. *She moved on 26 Nov 1866
