 John C. Smith, in this twentieth day of April in the year one thousand
 eight hundred and eighty four before the subscribers one of the Judges of the
 Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Green and State of New York personally
 appeared Jesse Kilabulee Resident of the Town of Windham in the County of
 Green and who affirmed upon oath that he being by the first duty sworn
 according to Law doth solemnly make the following declaration in order
 to obtain the provisions made by the Act of Congress entitled an act
 to provide for certain persons engaged in the Civil and Naval Service
 of the United States in the Revolutionary War that the said Jesse Kilabulee
 he enlisted in the Month of March in the year one thousand
 seven hundred and seventy five in the State of Connecticut in the
 Company Commanded by Captain William Munroe in the
 Regiment Commanded by Colonel Moses Hopton or Hayle in which
 said Corps he continued to serve until peace took place when
 he was discharged from service in the Month of July in the year
 one thousand seven hundred and eighty three at Springfield
 in the State of New Jersey in the Battalion for the Town of Spring
 Cornwall, and that he at that time received Certificates of discharge
 in need of the assistance of his Country for support and
 has no other evidence now of his service of his said service
 except the affidavits of John Shaw which accompanies the
 provisions

I Minors Bond one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and
 for the County of Green and State of New York do hereby certify that it appears
 to my satisfaction that the said Jesse Kilabulee did serve in the Revolutionary
 War as stated in the preceding declaration against the Common Enemy and
 I now transmit the provisions and Certificates herein and had before me
 to the Secretary for the Department of War pursuant to the directions of the
 aforementioned act of Congress given under my hand and official of the
 Court this twentieth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred
 and eighty four

At a County Court, held in and for the County of
North Haven, in the District and State of Connecticut, on the 16th
day of July 1820, the same being a Court of Record, and
having a Seal, by virtue of the laws of said State.

PERSONALLY APPEARED, in open Court, *John Blakesley* a resident in the town of
North Haven in the County of *North Haven* in said State, and exhibited and subscribed
the following Schedule, and made *oath* that the same is a true and perfect Schedule of all his in-
come and property, necessary cloathing and bedding excepted, viz:

I have no property of any description whatever but
am entirely dependent on public charity for support
except the assistance I have received from the U.S. as
a revolutionary pensioner
At the time of my first application for a pension
on the 30th day of April 1818 from that time until
the first of June last past I resided in the town
of *Westham* County of *Green* State of *New York*
but now reside in the town of *North Haven*
aforesaid

Be it Remembered, That in the *County* Court, held in and for the *County* of *Sturhaven*, in the District and State aforesaid, on this *6th* day of *July* 1820, the same being a Court of Record, and having a Seal, under the authority of said State, personally came and appeared in open Court, *Jesse Blakesley* aged *67* years, resident in the Town of *North Haven* in the County of *Sturhaven* in said State, and being *Sworn* according to Law, doth on his Oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War, as follows:

seven months in the year 1775 in the regiment of Col^l Waterbury, nine months in the year 1776 in Col^l Elmore's regiment and on the 10th day of April 1779 he was listed into the company of William Sherman in the regiment commanded by Charles Rogers served until honourably discharged in June 1783

that the original Declaration made by him, for the purpose of obtaining a pension under the Act of Congress of the 18th of March 1818, was dated the *30th* day of *April* 1818; that in pursuance thereof he was entered in the list of Pensioners, and received a Pension Certificate No. *5045* And I do further solemnly

that I was a resident citizen of the United States, on the 18th day of March, 1818, and that I have not since that time, by gift, sale, or in any manner, disposed of my property or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it, as to bring myself within the provisions of an Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War," passed on the 18th day of March, 1818; and that I have not, nor has any person, in trust, for me, any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me; nor have I any income other than what is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and by me subscribed. And I do further declare that my occupation is *farming but am*

unable to labour in consequence of sickness and bodily disability

and that I have ^{one} family residing with me, *consisting of a wife aged 48 years who is dependent on me alone for support and that I have been long obliged to beg for a living*

all which is subscribed by me the day and year aforesaid.
