within the term of three years after my decease in full satisfaction of
his portion. I give unto Elizabeth Snowden my eldest daughter
the sum of ten pounds within six months after my decease in full satisfaction
of her portion. I give unto James Snowden my second son the sum
of ten pounds to be paid when he shall come to the age of one twenty years
if he shall come before he attain to the age of one twenty years
and if that the sum of fifteen pounds shall be paid to Elizabeth Snowden his
sister at the same number of years. I give unto Martha my daughter
the sum of twenty pounds to be paid at the end of the term of three years after
my decease. I give unto Phillippa my youngest daughter the sum of thirty
pounds to be paid when she shall attain to the age of one twenty years
in full satisfaction of which portion I give unto the Countess of Huntingdon
the sum of ten pounds amongst them after my decease all the rest of my goods
and chattels and of my debts & funeral or charges discharged I give unto
Thomas Spilman my youngest son whom I do make whole & sole executor
of my last will & testament. I do make my loving friends Anthony
Snowden & Michael Snowden Supervisors & finding them to see this my last

Tom Smith located and copied the will of Thomas Spillman. It reads:

God amen August the fifteenth 1683. I Thomas Spillman the County of Lincoln, Gent being weak in body but of _____ memory, thanks be to God for it, do I make and ordain this my last Will and Testament I the manner and form following, renouncing all other Wills by me formerly I bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty God and Jesus saviour Wordly estate that God hat given me I dispose followeth. Item, I give unto Mary my wife and to her heirs forever within the manor of Claworth in the County of Nottingham be they more or less which I bought of Mary Royston the manor of long Close and alsoe sixty pounds to be paid to my said wife of one year after my decease which _____ of marriage. Item, I give unto Thomas Spillman my oldest sonne five pounds to be paid expiration of three years after my decease in full satisfaction of portion. Item, I give unto Elizabeth Snowden my oldest daughter five __ to be paid within six months after my decease in full satisfaction childs portion. Item, I give unto James Snowdon my grandchilde the sum __ pounds to be paid when he shall __ to the age of one and twenty years The said James dye before he attain to the age of one and twenty years my Will is that the sd fifteen pounds shall paid to Elizabeth Snowdon his sister at the same number of years. Item, I give unto Martha my daughter the sum of twenty pounds to be paid at the end __ of three years after Item, I give unto Phillippa my youngest daughter the sum of thirty pounds to be paid when she shall attain to the age of three and twenty years in full satisfaction of a childs portion. Item, I give unto the poor of Winteringham __ shillings to be disposed amongst them after my decease. All the rest of my goods chattels undisposed of my of my debts and funeral _____ I give unto (Daniell) Spillman my youngest sonne whom I do and make whole and sole executor m6 last Will and Testament and I do make my loveing friends Anthony Bainton and Michaelll Snowdon supervisors desiring them to see that this my last _____ and I give to them _shilling a __ in Wittness - where of __ have here unto sett my hand and seale the day and year above written.
