 the sum of twenty pounds to be paid at the end of the term of three years after
 my decease & also give unto Phillippa my youngest daughter the sum of thirty
 pounds to be paid when she shall attain to the age of one & twenty years
 in full satisfaction of her portion & also give unto the poor of Blintworth
 the sum of ten pounds to be distributed amongst them after my decease all the rest of my goods
 & chattels & also of my debts & funeral or charges discharged I give unto
 Thomas Spilman my youngest son whom I do make whole & sole executor
 of my last will & testament & I do make my loving friends Anthony
 & Michael Snowden Supervisors & finding them to see this my last
 will & testament & give to them some shilling a piece in Blintworth whereof

Item, I give unto Mary my wife and to her heirs forever within the manor of Claworth in the County of Nottingham be they more or less which I bought of Mary Royston the manor of long Close and alsoe sixty pounds to be paid to my said wife of one year after my decease which _____ of marriage. Item, I give unto Thomas Spillman my oldest sonne five pounds to be paid expiration of three years after my decease in full satisfaction of portion. Item, I give unto Elizabeth Snowden my oldest daughter five __ to be paid within six months after my decease in full satisfaction childs portion. Item, I give unto James Snowdon my grandchilde the sum __ pounds to be paid when he shall __ to the age of one and twenty years The said James dye before he attain to the age of one and twenty years my Will is that the sd fifteen pounds shall paid to Elizabeth Snowdon his sister at the same number of years.
