

BANKRUPTCIES, ARRANGEMENTS, LIQUIDATIONS, DISSOLUTIONS, &c.

THE BANKRUPTCY ACT, 1883.

[A petition may be presented by or against a debtor. If it be presented by a debtor a receiving order is made forthwith; if by a creditor, then the Order is made after the hearing of the petition. The effect of this Order is to vest the debtor's property in the Official Receiver, and to stay all proceedings. At the time of making the Receiving Order the Court is to fix a day for the Public Examination, which every debtor must pass. The Official Receiver is to summon a First Meeting of Creditors not later than fourteen days after the date of the Receiving Order, and he is to advertise seven days notice of time and place. At this meeting the creditors may resolve to accept a composition or scheme of arrangement, or they may decide that the debtor shall be adjudicated. An order of adjudication will be made at any time upon the debtor's own application. In other cases it will be made if the creditors so resolve, if nothing is done at the First Meeting, or if a scheme or composition is not confirmed.]

[An Administrator Order is made upon a debtor's own request, in accordance with the provisions of sec. 132 of the Act, and the Special Rules. There must be an unpaid County Court Judgment against him, and he must not owe more than £50 altogether. Every creditor scheduled by the debtor will receive notice of the hearing of his application, and he can attend and be heard by the judge. Notice of the order will be sent to all the creditors, and to the Registrar of County Court Judgments. It will also be posted in the County Court of the debtor's own district. The effect of the order is to stay all proceedings against the debtor in any County Court or any Inferior Court. Landlords can still distain for rent up to a year's arrears. But if an execution be issued against the debtor for the benefit of all creditors his household goods, clothes, and tools up to £20 together are protected.]
